TANGAZO LA NAFASI ZA WAJUMBE WA BARAZA LA USHAURI LA WATUMIAJI WA HUDUMA ZA USAFIRI WA ANGA (TCAA-CCC)

1. UTANGULIZI

Baraza la Ushauri la Watumiaji wa Huduma za Usafiri wa Anga (TCAA-CCC) limeundwa chini ya Kifungu cha 56(2) cha Sheria ya Usafiri wa Anga Sura ya 80 Toleo la Mwaka 2020. Baraza lina wajibu wa kutetea na kuwakilisha maslahi ya watumiaji wa huduma za usafiri zinazodhibitiwa na TCAA.

Kwa mujibu wa Sheria hiyo, Waziri mwenye dhamana na masuala ya Uchukuzi amepewa mamlaka ya kuteua wajumbe wa Baraza kutoka mionganini mwa wadau au watumiaji wa huduma za usafiri wa Anga wenye sifa za kujaza nafasi hizo.

Ili kuwezesha uteuzi huo, Katibu Mkuu anakaribisha maombi kutoka kwa Watanzania wenye sifa na uwezo wa kujaza nafasi za Wajumbe wa Baraza la Ushauri la Watumiaji wa Huduma za Usafiri wa Anga kama ilivyoainishwa katika tangazo hili.

2. KAZI ZA BARAZA LA USHAURI LA WATUMIAJI HUDUMA ZA USAFIRI WA ANGA

Kwa mujibu wa Kifungu cha 57(1) cha Sheria ya Usafiri wa Anga majukumu ya Baraza ni pamoja na:-

- (a) Kuwakilisha maslahi ya watumiaji kwa kufanya mawasilisho, kutoa maoni na taarifa na kushauriana na TCAA, Waziri pamoja na Mawaziri wa Sekta nyingine zinazodhibitiwa na TCAA
- (b) Kupokea na kusambaza taarifa na maoni kuhusiana na mambo yenyе maslahi kwa watumiaji wa huduma na bidhaa zinazodhibitiwa na TCAA;
- (c) Kuunda Kamati za Watumiaji wa Huduma za usafiri wa Anga za Mikoa na za Kisekta zinazodhibitiwa na TCAA na kushauriana na Kamati hizo;na
- (d) Kufanya utafiti juu ya mambo yanayoathiri maslahi ya Watumiaji wa Sekta inayodhibitiwa na TCAA.

3. SIFA ZA WAOMBAJI

Kwa mujibu wa Kifungu cha 56(4) cha Sheria ya Usafiri wa Anga, Uteuzi wa Wajumbe wa Baraza utazingatia watu waliohitimu Kidato cha Nne/Sita waliofuzu Shahada/Stashahada ya Juu na wenyе uelewa wa kutosha juu ya maslahi ya watumiaji wa huduma zinazodhibitiwa na TCAA ikiwa ni pamoja na maslahi ya:-

- (a) Watu wenyе kipato cha chini;
- (b) Jumuia za wenyе viwanda na wafanyabiashara;

(c) Serikali na mashirika ya kijamii.

4. JINSI YA KUTUMA MAOMBI

Maombi yote yaambatishwe na taarifa binafsi (CV), nakala za vyeti vya taaluma, picha ndogo ya rangi (passport size) ya hivi karibuni pamoja na majina ya wadhamini watatu (3) yakiwa na anuani kamili, barua pepe na namba zao za simu.

VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT FOR MEMBERS OF THE TANZANIA CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY CONSUMER CONSULTATIVE COUNCIL.

1. BACKGROUND

The Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority Consumer Consultative Council was established under Section 56(2) of the Civil Aviation Act No. 8 of 2020. The Council's mandate is to protect and represent the interests of consumers of TCAA's regulated goods and services.

As provided in the above-mentioned Act, the Minister for Transport is vested with powers to appoint the Council Members from among the qualified Stakeholders/Civil Aviation Services Consumers.

In facilitation of the said appointment, the Permanent Secretary invites qualified Tanzanians to fill vacancies of the Members of the Council as mentioned hereunder.

2. FUNCTIONS OF THE COUNCIL MEMBERS

Being the Member of the Council, the appointed person shall actively participate in the implementation of the functions of the Council as stipulated in Section 57(1) of the TCAA Act which include:-

- (a) To represent the interest of consumers by making submissions to, providing views and information to, and consulting with TCAA, Minister, and sector Ministers;
- (b) Receive and disseminate information and views on matters of interest to consumers of regulated goods and services;
- (c) Establish regional and sector consumer committees and consult with them;
- (d) To conduct research on the matters affecting the interest of consumers of the regulated sector

3. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

According to Section 56(4) of the TCAA Act, the consideration to memberships of the Council shall be given to persons who have completed Form Four/Six with Degree/Advanced Diploma Certificate and knowledge/ understanding of the interests of consumers and that of TCAA regulated services including the interests of: -

- (a) Low-income, rural and disadvantaged persons;

- (b) Industrial and business users;
- (d) Government and community organizations;

4. MODE OF APPLICATION

All applications must be accompanied by copies of academic certificates, detailed curriculum vitae (CV), one recent passport-size photograph, names and contact details of three (3) referees including their addresses, telephone numbers and e-mail.
