

Different types of English Riding Saddles

The type of saddle you need will depend on the size of your upper leg. The table below lists the various sizes based on your leg length. To determine the proper size, sit on an armchair with your feet flat on the floor and then push backward against the seat. Find the distance between your tip to your buttocks to the seat.
