

Tissue paper and foil collage

Materials Needed:

Sheet of aluminum foil
Newspaper or Styrofoam meat tray
Tissue paper
Scissors
tape
Elmer's Glue
Small throw away bowl or paint
Paint brush
Optional decorations sequins, buttons,
sharpie marker etc.



How to make collage:

1. Tear a piece of foil from the roll and cut into a square or rectangle
2. Tape it down on your newspaper or Styrofoam tray so it doesn't move
3. Cut pieces of tissue into assorted shapes and sizes – squares, triangles, circles, rectangles, hearts
4. Pour some glue into a small disposable bowl or paper plate
5. Using your paint brush, paint small areas of the foil with glue
6. Place pieces of tissue on the glue
7. Tap down the pieces into the glue
8. Continue to paint areas with glue and add tissue until all areas are covered
9. Overlapping is fun! You will create new colors when they blend together
10. If you have extra decorations to add to your collage put drops of glue down and add items
11. Wash out brush carefully with soap and warm water. If glue stays in the brush it will be ruined
12. Let your collage dry
13. Add a drawing with a black sharpie on top of your finished collage or keep it plain
