No Man's Sky, Beyond has had further revelations this week, with PCGamer writing an article that reviewed their experience with No Man's Sky VR. In this article, they stress how well the game is suited for VR and that it is a very immersive experience for the user. While the evaluation of NMS VR was the primary concern, there was also a mention of NPCs moving in a space station. This is a large step for Hello Games, as the three year old game has never had walking NPCs before, besides animals, sentinels, and other starships. That being said, all things are conjecture, other than the fact that NPCs do indeed move in Space Stations.

GHDF Expands

The GHDF Head Security Officer, u/MrJordanMurphy, announced on April 3rd the newest members of the GHDF. After evaluating 238 candidates, a total of 14 were selected to be trained and to serve as officers of the GHDF. This expands the GHDF from



approximately 80 officers to approximately 94 officers. This is almost a 20% increase in manpower for the GHDF. There are many reasons why the GHDF may be expanding, it may be for simple replenishment of their numbers as officers no doubt go through periods of time away from NMS. It may also be that they are trying to cover a greater amount of territory as the Hubble Zone continues to expand, or even perhaps out of concern of the potentially unstable security situation the Galactic Hub may find itself in post-Beyond.

Whatever the reason, it appears the GHDF wishes to continue to increase it's manpower, as u/MrJordanMurphy added at the end of the announcement that anyone that was not selected or has not applied is welcome to apply for the GHDF, as the applications will be reviewed and selected from on a monthly basis. With this, one can say with certainty, the the Galactic Hub will maintain power in the galaxy for the foreseeable future.

A New Federation Member

Exposé: Wild Space



This Sunday, I interviewed the Spyder, an individual that co-founded a community known as Wild Space. Wild Space is a community that was founded by the Spyder and Pythia of Elysium, and is the spiritual successor of the Underworld Hub. Wild Space is a place outside of Federation reach and therefore was a unique opportunity for myself to learn more of their community.

Wild Space is a community hub of non-Federation civilizations, and individuals that maybe part of the Federation, or not. Many individuals I talked to were open about much of the community's history, from the legacy community, Underworld Hub, to their views of current galactic politics. Since Wild Space's founding back in November, many have joined the community, often with a distaste of the Federation. Many in fact were formerly part of the Federation, however that does not mean that they feel ill to the Federation, only that they no longer wish to be apart of it. This group maybe smaller than the Federation, however I noticed immediately a lack of politicking involved in their discussions, and a more unified front from their responses.

The Federation has kept tabs on Wild Space, MrJordanMurphy is on the list of users on the Wild Space server. I currently have not been able to find the Federation's official stance regarding Wild Space, however as far as I can tell Wild Space has no desire to be a threat to the Federation. In fact, Wild Space has had close relations with other communities UN42.

Overall, I would say that Wild Space has been an interesting experience. Much of what you will find here is unlike what you would find in the Federation, and it's honestly refreshing. I think many people believe that there is little beyond the Federation to be apart of, but I can certainly say that there is a lot of diverse and independent groups in this universe and they are happy to accept anyone with open arms.
