

Jim Jordan Backs Trump's Reaction to Durham's Findings

Ohio Rep. Jim Jordan stated that Donald Trump was 'right on the mark' when he suggested that Hillary Clinton's operatives should be killed after the former president accused her campaign of treason.

Trump unleashed a furious rant against Clinton Saturday after John Durham, the special counsel, claimed that her team was attempting to spy on White House servers to discover ties to Russia in order to discredit the former president.

The one-term president said Durham's report was more extensive than Watergate, and suggested that all those involved be prosecuted, and most likely, executed.

'In a more tense period of time in our country, this crime would have been punishable by death,' he stated.

On Sunday, Jordan appeared on Fox & Friends where said backed Trump's assertion.

'We've never seen anything like this in history before,' Jordan said. "So President Trump's speech yesterday, I think is right on target. This is truly unprecedented and has never happened in the history of our great country.'

Jordan added that the 'spying was more serious than we believed.'

After Jordan refused to be interviewed, the committee is now debating whether to summon Jordan.

Jordan stated to CNN that he had spoken to President Obama a few times throughout the day, but didn't recall the times.

After Trump's unsuccessful effort to keep them secret, the Supreme Court ruled in his favor and the call logs were turned over to the House Committee.

"President Trump was correct. Remember in 2017, when President Trump said they [Democrats] were spying on me and all the press and all the Democrats said no, they weren't and then in 2019, then-Attorney-General Bill Barr said spying took place...' Jordan told Fox & Friends hosts on Sunday.

"Well we know...Yes, there was spying taking place, and it was worse that we thought because they were spying on the sitting President of America.

'We do know this, John Durham is going right back to the start...It is all about the lies that started in 2016, when they started the concerted effort to take on the Presidential campaign. That's what's so frightening here,' Jordan added.

On Saturday, Trump ranted that Team Clinton's behavior would once be a reason to execute them.

Following Durham's disclosures, it was revealed that Hillary Clinton's campaign had paid money to a company that used technology to "mine data" from servers at Trump Tower and later the White House, they spoke.
