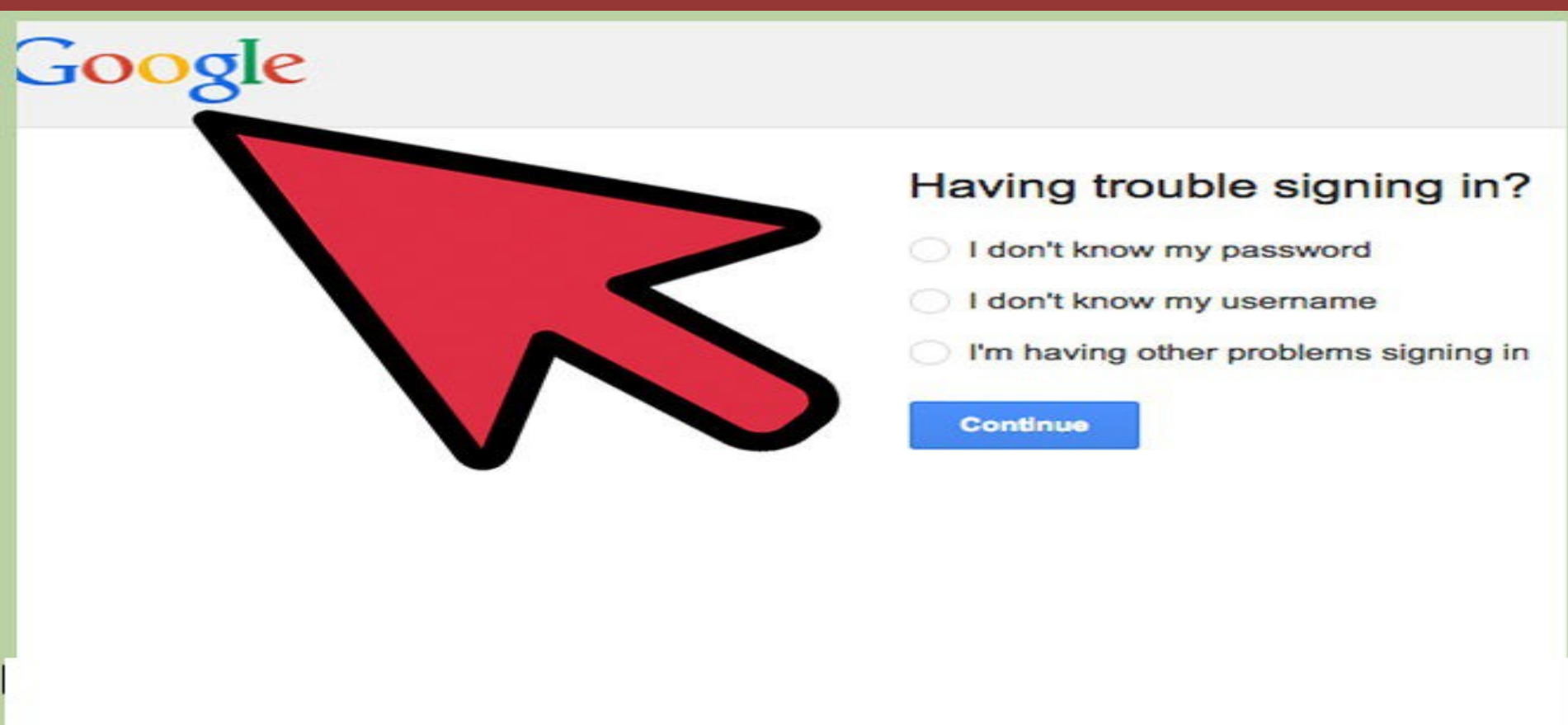
Follow these method and retrieve Gmail account password:

1. Method 1 of 2: First Using the Account Recovery Page

If you have forgotten your Gmail password and you have a phone number or alternate email address associated with your account. Google can send you a link to a password reset page. If you don't have either of these associated with your account, see the next method.

Visit google.com/accounts/recovery/ to start the process.

Alternatively, load the Gmail page and click the "Need help?" link underneath the login box.



2. Select "I don't know my password" option . Now you need to enter the Google account email address that you are trying to recover. If you can't remember your username, select that option instead. Click the "Continue" button.

To reset your password, enter the email address you use to sign in to Google. This can be your Gmail address, your Google Apps email address, or another email address associated with your account.

3. Click "I don't know" or enter your last known password. Entering your last known password can help the recovery process, but isn't required to retrieve your account.

4. Now **Choose your recovery option**. You can either have your recovery details sent to your alternate email address or to your mobile phone. You will need to have set these for your account in order to be able to use them. If you don't have recovery information associated with your account, you will be taken to the account retrieval survey.

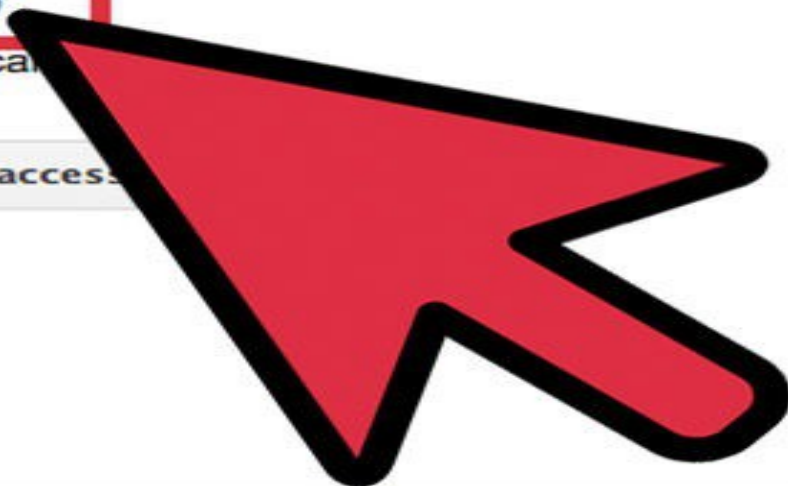
