CAJUN FIELD IS THE FIRST STADIUM IN LOUISIANA TO MOVE TOWARDS ZERO WASTE. WE AIM TO DIVERT 90% OF MATERIALS AWAY FROM THE LANDFILL BY RECYCLING, COMPOSTING, AND FOOD RECOVERY.

RECYCLE AND COMPOST

WE HAVE ELIMINATED MATERIALS THAT CAN ONLY BE SENT TO THE LANDFILL, SUCH AS STYROFOAM. INSTEAD, WE ARE SERVING FOOD AND BEVERAGES IN CONTAINERS THAT ARE REUSABLE, RECYCLABLE, OR COMPOSTABLE.

ZERO WASTE STATIONS, WITH RECYCLE AND COMPOST BINS, HAVE REPLACED ALL TRASHCANS IN THE CONCOURSE AREAS. STUDENT VOLUNTEERS WILL BE THROUGHOUT THE STADIUM TO HELP FANS CHOOSE THE RIGHT BIN.

COMPOSTABLE MATERIALS WILL BE TAKEN TO CADE FARM WHERE RESEARCHERS WILL COMPOST IT ALONG WITH SUGARCANE BAGASSE AND YARD WASTE. RECYCLABLES WILL BE TAKEN TO A MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY, THEN RE-MANUFACTURED INTO NEW PRODUCTS

SURPLUS FOOD WILL BE COLLECTED BY VOLUNTEERS, AND WITH THE HELP OF SECOND HARVEST FOODBANK, MADE ACCESSIBLE TO LOCAL FAMILIES IN NEED
