

"Indeed, in this [Quran] is notification for a worshipping people. And We have not sent you, [O Muhammad], except as a mercy to the worlds." (A-anbiyāa: 106-107)

One of the main measures of our iman or faith is our love for our beloved prophet Muhammad (PBUH), in fact, our iman is not completed until our love to our Prophet exceeds our love for anything else, even ourselves. In surat Al-Ahzab, Allah said: "The Prophet is preferable for the believers even to their own selves..." (33:6). The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) said: "None of you becomes a believer until I am dearer to him than his children, his parents and all mankind." (as reported by Bukhari and Muslim). Some versions add: "his life, his wealth and his family".

'Alī ibn Abī Tālib was asked once about the level of love of the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) in the hearts of his companions, he said: "The Holy Prophet is dearer to us than our wealth, our children, our fathers, our mothers and cool water at the time of severe thirst."

Anas bin Malik Narrated: A man asked the Prophet (PBUH) about the Hour (i.e. Day of Judgment) saying, "When will the Hour be?" The Prophet (PBUH) said, "What have you prepared for it?" The man said, "Nothing, except that I love Allah and His Apostle." The Prophet (PBUH) said, "You will be with those whom you love." Anas Said: We had never been so glad as we were on hearing that saying of the Prophet (i.e., "You will be with those whom you love.") Therefore, I love the Prophet, Abu Bakr and `Umar, and I hope that I will be with them because of my love for them though my deeds are not similar to theirs.

Allah's Messenger (PBUH) was the kindest of men in the same way as he excelled all others in courage. He said: "Allah has commanded you to show kindness to everyone, so if you have to kill, kill in a good manner, and if you slaughter an animal, slaughter it gently. If anyone of you has to slay an animal, he should sharpen the blade first and treat the animal well." Ibn 'Abbas relates that a man threw a goat on its side and then started sharpening his knife. When the Prophet saw him he said: "Do you want to kill it twice? Why did you not sharpen the knife before throwing it on the ground?"

Think are many examples that highlight the character of the Prophet of mercy (PBUH), such as when he showed mercy when the people of at-Taa'if rejected him and harmed him severely for calling them to believe in the Oneness of Allah. He did not want anything from them apart from that.

Al-Bukhaari and Muslim narrated that 'Aa'ishah (may Allah be pleased with her), the wife of the Prophet (PBUH) said to the Prophet (PBUH): Was there ever a day that was worse for you than the day of Uhud? He said: "I suffered at the hands of your people, and the worst that I suffered from them was the day of al-'Aqabah, when I presented myself to Ibn 'Abd Yaleel ibn 'Abd Kulaal, and he did not respond to what I wanted. So I went, with signs of distress on my face, and I did not recover until I was in Qarn al-Tha'aalib, where I lifted my head and saw that a cloud was shading me. I looked and saw therein Jibraa'eel (peace be upon him), who called me and said: Allah has heard what your people said to you, and how they have rejected you. He has sent to you the angel of the mountains, so that you can tell him to do whatever you want to them. Then he called the angel of the mountains to me and he greeted me with salaam, then said: O Muhammad, Allah has heard what your people have said to you, and I am the angel of the mountains. Your Lord has sent me so that you can tell me what to do. What do you want? If you wish I will bring together the two mountains of Makkah to crush them. The Messenger of Allah (PBUH) said to him: "Rather, I hope that Allah will bring forth from their loins people who will worship Allah alone, not associating anything with Him."

As we are watching bloodshed every day and night around the world, we need to remember that our beloved Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) did not kill anyone except one person as the scholars said: "The Prophet (PBUH) was the most perfect of people in terms of his courage that is required of leaders in war, but he did not kill anyone with his hand except Ubay ibn Khalaf, whom he killed on the day of Uhud. He did not kill anyone else with his own hand before or after that."

The Prophet (PBUH) showed mercy for the believers, and for the non believers. He showed mercy towards his enemies. He showed his mercy to men, women, children, orphans, and widows. The Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) showed his mercy to domestic workers, animals, and even the inanimate objects. He was a mercy to mankind.

"Allah sends His Salaah (Graces, Blessings, Mercy) on the Prophet (Muhammad), and also His angels (Angels ask Allah to bless and forgive him). O you who believe! Send your Salah on (ask Allah to bless) him (Muhammad), and greet him with the Islamic way of greeting (salutation, i.e. As-Salaamu 'Alaykum)" [Al-Ahzaab 33:56]
