On the 30th November we will have a dinner at a Fado house (Casa de Fados), located in one of the city's oldest and most emblematic neighborhoods, which boasts a centuries-old tradition of dining and the arts. In combining these two elements, our restaurant offers you the chance to sample and experience our traditions, by spending an agreeable night featuring the flavors of traditional Portuguese cusine - famed for the quality of its ingredients together with the music that runs through the soul of all Portuguese: FADO.



On the 1st December by 8 pm, we will have a night in the Military Museum with Ton Puey. Puey will give a workshop of Luis Godiño Montante.

Tourists keen on the history of artillery and warfare should definitely head for the Military Museum of Lisbon. The museum is said to feature one of the finest and widest collections of swords, fire arms and, generally speaking, warfare-related items in the world. Highlights refer to a massive 14th century bronze cannon (weighing more than 20 tons), to Vasco da Gama's sword (displayed in the Vasco da Gama room, where there are also showcased items related to the history of the way the sea route to India was discovered), to the collection of World War One exhibits and to the Portuguese artillery section.

The museum also accommodates a scattered collection of fine art works (chiefly, paintings and sculptures).



On the 2nd December we will have a visit to LISBON STORY CENTER.

Located in the Terreiro do Paço, this interactive equipment that tells us, from past to present, the major city events. Built on the hills bathed by the river Tejo, and with eyes fixed on the Atlantic Ocean, Lisbon is a fascinating mosaic of memories, stories and influences that still dot the urban landscape of this unique city The various episodes that make up its history and some of its protagonists are now presented in Lisbon Story Centre, where all who visit the Portuguese capital are invited to make a journey through time and discover the memories of Lisbon, from its founding to the present day. Located in the Terreiro do Paço, this equipment and interactive technologybased account, from past to present, the major city events.
