# MANAGER PREVIEW

WITH JOHN ROBERTSON

Good afternoon and welcome to today's Ladbrokes Championship clash against Ayr United here at the Caledonian Stadium.

In particular I warmly welcome Mark Kerr, Michael McArdle and their players, directors and, of course, the fans of the Honest Men who have travelled north today to support their side.

It's the old cliché, they are all big games but of course they are. The fact that it's second against third and there's only a couple of points between us then obviously it makes it even bigger. I'm sure Ayr will be wanting to win the game and leapfrog back into second and we obviously want to create a little gap.

We're building up nicely, we've had three clean sheets, three wins and we want that to continue, especially at home. We know what we have to do to see us through until the end of the year, we know what's required and if the players play as they have been in the last three weeks then we've got every opportunity. The first thing is always to look up the way, ourselves and Ayr know the significance of the game, as we did a couple of weeks against Dundee but we should be looking up the way.

We talked about that to the players, we've said that all week, once we debriefed from the Alloa match it's Ayr next and let's look up the way. That's the aim of the game, to try and take the three points and keep the pressure on United, who are setting a tremendous pace and fair play to them but we've got to try and put a run of wins together to try and close the gap and hang in there. I think Ayr have been disrupted recently due to the weather, they've lost a couple of games including against Dunfermline in mid-week.

They didn't get the result they wanted but only playing a couple of times in the past four or five weeks is difficult. They would have been desperate to play so that's maybe effected them a little bit. They'll come here confident, they've got good players and they showed that early on down at Somerset Park where they were terrific for the first 20 minutes against us but we have to be ready for that.

Ayr's form is irrelevant, we're trying to look at ourselves, how well we are playing, can we keep it going, can we keep the things we are doing well up and can we work on the things that we're not so good at. We understand we've got weaknesses but the whole point is looking at the positives and we've done a lot of things really well in the past three weeks and we want to continue that today in what will be another really tough game.

Once more we thank you for your continued support.

**Caley Thistle moved up to second place in the Championship table thanks to a 2-0 win at Recreation Park against Alloa. An Own Goal from Scott Taggart and a stunning strike from Aaron Doran sealed all three points.**

John Robertson made two changes to the side that beat Dundee last weekend as Shaun Rooney and James Keatings replaced Brad McKay and Kevin McHattie.

Caley Thistle had a big chance to open the scoring after 14 minutes as James Keatings spotted Carl Tremarco in the middle of the box but his header went wide of the post as he couldn't fully connect with it.

Keatings was the provider four minutes later as he spotted Doran free on the edge of the box from a corner but the Irishman's effort was deflected into the gloves of MacDonald.

After 20 minutes, Caley Thistle almost had the lead after a fantastic team move. Miles Storey bombed down the wing and his cross was back-heeled by Doran into the path of White, the Caley Thistle number nine then laid the ball into the path of Keatings but his effort was palmed away by MacDonald.

Mark Ridgers produced a fine save as he was called into action after 26 minutes, he tipped Flannigan's effort from about 20 yards over the bar to keep the game level.

The Caley Thistle keep was called into action just 9 minutes later as he produced another massive save. Alan Trouten broke into the box but somehow saw his effort kept out from the Caley Thistle number one.

The Caley Jags got the breakthrough after 37 minutes, it was in a fortunate fashion as David Carson saw his long pass, which was aimed for Tremarco, headed by Scott Taggart past his own goalkeeper!

Caley Thistle then had another just before the break, Shaun Rooney saw his cross knocked down by Jordan White into the path of Aaron Doran, who volleyed it into the top corner to make it 2-0.

In the second-half, Miles Storey had a go from about 25 yards but his effort was over the bar.

Alloa were then down to ten men after 58 minutes, Liam Dick was sent off after a strong tackle on James Keatings.

With twenty minutes to go, Kevin Cawley was presented with a big chance for the home side as he was found free in the box but he headed over the bar.

Kevin O'Hara then almost found the net for Alloa as his effort from a tight angle come off the post.

Roddy MacGregor almost added a third late on, the substitute fired a shot from the edge of the box but saw his effort saved by MacDonald.

**Following wins against Dundee and Alloa, James Keatings is looking forward to another big match for the Caley Jags today against Ayr United. After two back-to-back 3-0 defeats against Dundee United and Arbroath, the Caley Jags have responded with a penalty shootout win against Clyde, A 1-0 win against Dundee and a 2-0 win against Alloa last weekend.**

Keatings said: "We're looking forward to it especially with the way the last two results have went with the team getting their confidence back. It's another big one, these are the games you want to play in and want to take the most out of. It's another big game, hopefully we can take the two performances from Dundee and Alloa away into this game and build on it again."

On the Alloa game, Keatings thinks Caley Thistle showed their real qualities in the first-half and thought it was a good performance overall.

The Caley Thistle Number 7 said: "It was a good performance, Alloa is a difficult place to go. We knew it was going to be a tough game but I thought in the first-half we showed our qualities on the ball."

"We moved it well, got into good positions and we showed how good a team we can be. Obviously, in the second-half it was a wee bit stop-start but the most important thing was getting the win down there, we've seen teams go there and struggle so the three points was the main thing."

Caley Thistle have now kept three clean sheets on the bounce and Keatings is confident that if the team keeps clean sheets at one end then they'll take chances at the other.

He said: "Any team wants to start with keeping clean sheets, you can always work on the attacking players taking the chances at the other end. If we've got a clean sheet I'm more than sure this team will get a goal in a game so it is credit to the back four and the full team defending from the front."

"Ridgers in goal has been brilliant in the past few games as well, so it is great knowing as an attacker that you're solid at the back and when the chances come we know we have to take them."

Liam Dick was shown a red card in the second-half for a strong tackle on Keatings but he says he's fine and it's part and parcel of playing his position.

Keatings said: "It was just stud marks on my shin, I've not seen the tackle back but it's one of these things you are going to get in my position on the pitch. It was one of those things, it was beneficial for us in the game. It's one of those things when you get tackled you get on with it, luckily it wasn't one that got me injured so I'm totally fine with it."

Keatings is expecting a tough match this afternoon, he thinks Ayr have quality players and that their league position shows how good a side they are

He said: "Ayr are always a strong side, hard working and have good quality players. They'll be a tough opposition again as you can see from the table, they've started the season strongly again and they're up there. It's up to us to focus on ourselves and do our jobs first and foremost, play our game and hopefully if we do that then we'll come out on top."

# ICTFC CODE OF CONDUCT

**Inverness Caledonian Thistle FC will not tolerate unacceptable conduct at the Caledonian Stadium or any away football stadia.**

**Unacceptable conduct is conduct which is deemed violent or disorderly.**

**Violent conduct is any actual, attempted or threatened physical violence against any person, or intentional damage to property.**

**Disorderly conduct includes:**

**Conduct which stirs up or sustains or is likely to or is designed to stir up or sustain hatred or ill will towards people or groups of people based on their membership of the following categories:**

- **Gender, Race, Nationality (including citizenship) or ethnic or national origin.**
- **Membership or presumed membership of a religious group or a social or cultural group with perceived religious affiliation.**
- **Sexual orientation**
- **Transgender Identity**
- **Disability**
- **Or against an individual who is perceived to be a part of such group**
- **Using threatening, abusive or insulting words or conduct**
- **Displaying or writing anything which is abusive or insulting**
- **Using words or conduct or displaying any writing or other thing which indicated the support or affiliation to, or the celebrating of, or opposition to an organisation or group proscribed in the terms of the terrorism act of 2000**

**All persons entering The Caledonian Stadium on a matchday are subject to these rules, including employees and volunteers of ICTFC whilst discharging their duties.**

**Any person who engages in unacceptable conduct will be liable for sanctions imposed by the club, which may involve possible criminal proceedings, ejection from the stadium, withdrawal of a season ticket and/or exclusion from future matches at the club.**
