This should install all the required dependencies for Debian based distributions like Ubuntu. If your environment doesnt have a graphical package installer you can install the package from the terminal like this:

apt-get install Minecraft.deb

On Arch and Arch based distributions, the package is available as minecraft-launcher from the AUR. AUR is a repository of packages maintained by the community. You can read more about how to use it on the Arch wiki.
