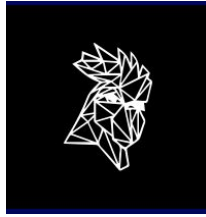


## Smart money is accumulating Tendies (TEND). Why aren't you, anon?

Let's look a bit closer ... It seems like this user used to have 43500 ETH - that's almost **15 million usd** at today's prices! Don't believe me? Check the blockchain.

Let's go in reverse order:

A year ago he [transferred](#) 700 ETH. The sender's address of the transfer is `oxbe404b30e89e7f14b5e250d01b3196c410d6edf8`.

Following this reverse trail, we find wallet address, `oxd31fbb94bdb5e470bdc01749606f28b3072559a1`, then on this [transaction](#), after following the path forward, we arrive at wallet address, `oxA6E75ddaa50B2687153C893986D05473884Ec919`.

This [transaction](#) proves that he once had 45000 ETH! It is **unlikely** to be an exchange wallet as it hasn't been active in 300 days. Doing a bit more searching, it seems like majority of the 45000 ETH remains [here](#).
