MESSAGE FROM THE IMAM

Islam & Religious Tolerance - Part II

One of the misconceptions about Islam is that Muslims are prohibited from making friends with people from other religions, while the truth is, this relates only to the people who were at war with the Muslims, which is actually the case in the modern laws of many countries. This is clearly stated in the Quran:

"Allah does not forbid you as regards those who do not fight you for religion, nor drive you forth from your homes, that you show them kindness and deal with them justly." (60:8, 9)

َ "لَا يَنْهَلُكُمُ ٱللَّهُ عَنِ ٱلَّذِينَ لَمَ يُقَاتِلُوكُمْ فِى ٱلدِّينِ وَلَمْ يُخْرِجُوكُم مِّن دِيَلِكُمْ أَن تَبَرُّوهُمْ وَتُقْسِطُوٓاْ إِلَيْهِمَّ إِنَّ ٱللَّهَ يُحِبُّ ٱلْمُقْسِطِينَ"

This fact didn't change whether Muslims were the minority or majority, as we can see in the tolerance of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) and his companions at all times. Before Hijra when they were minority, after Hijra where they continued to be a minority for many years, and even when they got all the power on the conquest of Makka (fath Makkah) on the 8th year of Hijra.

In Makkah, and in spite of all the opposition and even physical torture that Muslims faced, they always approached the unbelievers with tolerance. In Sūrat al-Kāfirūn: "O you who do not believe! I worship not what you worship, and you are not worshipping what I worship."

After the Hijra to Medina, Muslims found a large Jewish community in that city besides those who accepted Islam, but this did not bother them at all, instead, Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) made a peace agreement with them and called them the people of the Scripture (ahlul kitab) and he was prepared to live in peace with the followers of other religions, such as Judaism and Christianity.

In one of Prophet Muhammad's letters to the leaders of other countries, he said: "I have conveyed the message and now it is up to you to accept it. Once again, peace be upon him who follows the true guidance."

قَدْ بَلَغْتُ وَيَصَحْت فَاقْبَلُوا تَصِيحَتِي وَالسَّلَامُ عَلَى مَنْ اتَّبَعَ

In the Treaty of 'Umar ibn Al-Khattāb to the people of Jerusalem he said:

"This is the assurance of safety which the servant of God, Umar, the Commander of the Faithful, has given to the people of Jerusalem. He has given them an assurance of safety for themselves for their property, their churches, their crosses, the sick and healthy of the city and for all the rituals which belong to their religion. Their churches will not be inhabited by Muslims and will not be destroyed. Neither they, nor the land, on which they stand, nor their cross, nor their property will be damaged."

Roderic H. Davison, a prominent Western historian of the Ottoman Empire who taught at George Washington University from 1947 to 1993, writes:

"It might in fact have been argued that the Turks were less unjust of their subject people than were Prussians of the Poles, the English of the Irish, or the Americans of the Africans - There is evidence to show that in this period {late 19th century}, there was emigration from independent Greece into the Ottoman Empire, since some Greeks found the Ottoman government more tolerant master {than their own Greek government}.





MECCA CENTER HOSTS **#WeAreAllAmerica** Solidarity gathering For Neighbors and Faith community

The Mecca Center hosted a #WeAreAllAmerica solidarity event on Sunday, February 19 to celebrate the great diversity of the United States. Mecca Center invited neighbors and interfaith partners to come together for a gathering to say that Chicagoland faith communities resist President Donald Trump's "Muslim Ban" and harmful immigration policies. Later in the week, Mecca Center hosted Pastor Mike Solberg from the Union Church of Hinsdale and members of the nearby Unitarian Church.





