



Terms - conditions

General info

- Short films (no vlogs), all genres are accepted (for example: drama, horror, comedy, sci-fi, etc)
- The 72hrs The Hague film contest is open to unknown film talent with a link to The Hague (living, working or studying in The Hague (or immediate vicinity (Voorburg, Wassenaar etc)
- Contestants are 18 years or older
- The 72 hours in which the film has to be made starts on:
Tuesday 27 June at 11:00 am and ends on Friday 30 June at 11:00 am
- On day 1 (27 June) the contestants have to pick up the rules for the content of the film in person (information about exact location and time will be emailed to each contestant)
- Film maker (initiator) will form his own crew and cast
- Submitted films are property of 72hrs The Hague and can be shared online by the organisation (72hrs.nl, social media etc)
- Participating films cannot be shared on personal channels or social media before the premiere night on 3 July.
- Contestants will be informed by email about the technical requirements when submitting their film (acceptable formats etc)

REGISTRATION

- Registration starts on Monday 29 May 2017 at 8 am and closes on Wednesday 21 June 2017 at 11.59 pm.
- Film maker/producer is responsible for registration and will inform his or her team members
- No entry/registration fees
- Registration can be done online via the form on 72hrs.nl

PARTICIPANTS

- The maximum participating teams that can compete is 30.
The entries will be judged on the conditions as formulated above and in case of more than 30 entries, they will be selected on date/time (first come, first serve).
- The top 10 best films, selected by the jury, will be shown during the premiere night on 3 July 2017.

JUDGING

The submitted films will be judged on:

- Production quality / art direction
- Scenario and script
- Cinematography
- Acting
- Post production (editing/music/sound)
- Creativity
