In The Lobby

We are a laid back group. If you cannot take a joke or you don't know how to laugh, take constructive criticism or if you can't handle a lobby that may be extremely quiet at times then this isn't for you. Free speech can only go so far. Watch what you say and have respect for your fellow members. Know who the founders are and treat them with respect. There will be times where the conversation gets heated. If that happens, MUTE the person you don't want to talk to. If you cannot converse in a civilized matter and you simply must argue the dispute. Do so in a private party. At the end of the day it's just a game. We prefer things organized.

Socialclub/Gta Forums

All post on the social club/Gta Forums must be PPEor Car related. (*Pictures, Videos, Media, Events, Etc*) Defaming the crew name or advertising your own crew is a violation that will be dealt with accordingly. You MUST have your profile gamer tag visible in the crew. Failing to do so will get you kicked.

During the Car Show/Event

I'll make this extremely simple and straightforward for you to understand.

How you would act in "real life".. Apply that to every car show/event that the PPE host's.

No weapons, flares, explosives, or blunt objects. Always Walk (*move the analog forward*) NO RUNNING (*tapping A*) or JUMPING on cars or around the area. No punching or kicking another member's car. If you are slamming your car, do so AWAY from the initial meeting spot and use a Silenced weapon. If you are using a heavy Sniper, you must have BLIND-EYE On. Do not bring pedestrian vehicles or anything that is not part of the theme. If you don't know the theme, ask the host or the members! Your car must be in MINT condition at all times. You never know who may be filming on the low.

If you follow all these rules accordingly, there should never be a need to worry about Police. But if for some reason you get a wanted level. DO NOT CALL LESTER. Instantly Kill yourself (in game of course) (Calling Lester will cause the cops to show up to the spot and crash into other members cars)

While Cruising

How you would drive in "real life".. The same rules apply during the cruise

We drive somewhat REALISTICALLY. This means when there is a traffic jam, we WAIT in traffic. DO NOT PASS ON THE SHOULDER unless there is a wreck. THE LEFT LANE IS THE PASSING LANE. Do not hold it up. You are allowed to do flybys or pulls but do not drive far ahead of the group. Press the trigger down and then ease up so the engine slows the car down. If you don't know the limits of your car, DO NOT TAIL-GATE. Leave at least 1car lengths space or enough space to brake fast incase the Ai's decide to randomly brake check. Pay attention to your surroundings and look back before you decide to lane switch!

If we are in the mountains or on a 2-lane road that has a solid line, we only overtake when we aren't driving "Full Realistic". Overtake to your LEFT. NOT ON THE SHOULDER. Do not attempt to squeeze in tight spots. If you know you cannot make the pass, simply wait for the next one to open up

While in the city, we obey the traffic lines, lights and laws. This rule is only bent whenever the host decides to drive "Semi-Realistically" Only at that time do we ignore the traffic lights and Ai Traffic. However we continue to obey the traffic lines.

Below is the "ART" of waiting at a traffic light.

Every few seconds the ai will get impatient and forget that you are in front of them as they proceed to force you out the lane. To prevent this from happening, Every few seconds, lightly (and I mean lightly, the throttle is very sensitive) drive forward. Doing this technique will make the Ai's acknowledge that you are there and prevent them from causing damage to your vehicle so make sure you leave enough space while at the stop lights.

PATIENCE IS THE KEY

These Rules are mandatory. Breaking them may result in getting kicked from the crew. Continuously breaking them will get you banned. The only time these rules don't count is when a lobby is considered "Open" This means that the initial Carshow/event is over and the lobby restrictions are free. This is only by the discretion of the host!
