(v) <u>Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.</u>

Internship Program

KDFW/FOX4 & KDFI continues to offer an academic credit internship program for college/university, junior, senior and graduate students. Generally, internships are available in the following departments: News & Sports (Summer Only), Sales, Programming and Research and Creative Services (including Promotions and Marketing).

The objectives of the internship program are to:

- Provide students majoring in journalism, communications, media and related disciplines the opportunity to receive onsite exposure to and training from experienced television broadcast professionals who are in job positions to which students aspire.
- Provide students majoring in journalism, communications, and media and related disciplines the opportunity to garner practical application experience and exposure to a work environment in their desired career.
- Identify graduating students for the Stations' job applicant pool for employment opportunities.

Eligibility Criteria:

- College juniors, seniors, and graduate students.
- Receipt of academic credit.

The internship program is overseen by the Director of Human Resources. In this reporting year, we had a total of four (4) academic interns for the Summer Semester 2018.

5. (vii) Participation in scholarship programs designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting.

Work Study Scholarship Programs - Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interest in Media, Inc.

Established in 1989, the Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media is a non-profit organization whose mission is to create career opportunities in the media industry for minority youth through a program that focuses on scholastic achievement, direct work experience and professional development. Students in the program work in media companies each summer and during school breaks, from high school through college. The students earn both salaries and matching scholarship funds to be used for college tuition and related expenses. Over a period of up to five years, the students experience numerous aspects of corporate operation and develop professional and practical skills that will help prepare them for their careers, many of which begin at the companies where the students interned. Fox Television Stations, LLC has been a corporate partner in this program since its inception and two of the Company's executives are on the Foundation's Board.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Good academic standing and record
- Recommendation from principal, teachers and guidance counselors
- Interested in pursuing a career in media

KDFW & KDFI selected two students who began with the Station during the 2017 Summer Internship program. One of the students is an African American female who is now completing her sophomore year at the University of Missouri. The second Emma Bowen student is a Hispanic female completing her junior year at the University of San Diego. During their summer internships with us, these students were exposed to the different aspects of news gathering and operations, while also receiving hands-on training. Both students have confirmed that they will be returning for the 2019 Summer Internship program.

6. (viii) <u>Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions.</u>

The Director of Human Resources, KDFW & KDFI provides Management Training on a continual basis.

The station encourages employees to apply for promotional position opportunities for which they are qualified. In an effort to increase internal promotions, the station offers many internal cross-training opportunities. This enables employees to acquire the necessary skills and experience needed to be considered for advancement opportunities. In this reporting period, the Station has trained and promoted three (3) employees to the following positions: Associate Producer promoted to Producer, News Reporter promoted to Anchor and Reporter, and Reporter and Anchor promoted to Anchor and Reporter.

Fox Stations Sales, an in-house national sales organization, maintains a program to train new sales account executives. This program consists of both coursework and hands-on training. At the end of the program, individuals are assigned to the Company's Television Stations and Sales offices throughout the United States.
