- 1) What about life makes this account of Daniel 6 so important to understand and mediate on?  
(Illustration about Translator who was placed in a hard labor camp, Ro 8:35)
- 2) What does Daniel see in his present world? What does Daniel see beyond his world both looking forward and looking back? Looking forward and back in your own life where do you see God saying "I'm here, trust me?"
- 3) Why do you think the path of faithfulness is often through the path of suffering?  
(James 1:2-3)
- 4) We see Daniel being faithful in prayer and faithful in practice through the world of suffering, what did you learn from his example?  
(vs 10b,c,d 12, 15 "despite clocks, despite lions, despite titans ")  
How do you want that to take root in your own life?
