INTERNAL AFFAIRS INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

ISSUES

The complainant, Investigator Chris Wilkie, advised he had been contacted by [REDACTED] an [REDACTED] resident, concerning [REDACTED] (who resides in Lexington County, SC) receiving inappropriate text messages from a Lexington County Deputy; who was identified as Charles Browder. As a result, this investigation was initiated.

INVESTIGATIVE FINDINGS

On Friday, October 27th, I received a packet of information (Exhibit A) from Investigator Wilkie. I reviewed the packet, which also contained the contact number for [REDACTED]. The packet contained a series of screen shots from a cell phone (used by the [REDACTED]) are text messages via Facebook Messenger and Snapchat involving Deputy Browder and [REDACTED]. Additionally, it contained a letter (on Eighth Circuit Solicitor's Office letterhead) from Wilkie outlining his involvement in the matter.

The text messages contain casual conversations between Browder and the minor child; including their meeting on service calls involving the minor on two occasions. Furthermore, there were messages where Browder was asking if [REDACTED] was alone. He inquires with [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] could sneak out of the house to meet him.

I spoke with [REDACTED]'s custodian, [REDACTED], who is [REDACTED] concerning these messages. She advised that she wanted them stop and for the Deputy to not contact [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] could provide no further information. Ms. [REDACTED] agreed to meet with Investigator Mike Phipps from the LCSD Forensic Service Unit so he could download the [REDACTED]'s cell phone.

On Thursday, November 2nd, Investigator Phipps and Sergeant David Day met with [REDACTED]. She signed a voluntary consent to allow Phipps to download her [REDACTED]'s cellphone. Phipps advised he was able to download (Exhibit B), but the phone revealed that [REDACTED] had been uploading the messages and others items from the cell phone to more than one cloud server. He further advised the information he was able to view on the phone was the same as what had been provided. He added there was very little else due to the user uploading items to cloud servers. The [REDACTED] was unable to provide any information about the cloud servers, such as user names and passwords, and [REDACTED] was not present due to being at school. She agreed to speak with [REDACTED] about the issue, and see if [REDACTED] would give her the cloud server sites, usernames, and passwords.



Ms. [REDACTED] notified me that she has been unable to get [REDACTED] to provide the information needed to access the cloud servers in question for information related to this investigation. I discovered that on [REDACTED] Browder responded to a runaway call (Attachment A) involving the minor, and a call (Attachment B) for a motor vehicle theft on [REDACTED] with the minor. I did not locate any further contact in the RMS database involving the two parties.

On Wednesday, November 8th, I interviewed Deputy Charles Allen Browder, under *Garrity* (Attachment C), and he subsequently provided a statement (Exhibit C). Browder advised he had in fact been messaging the minor child [REDACTED] and he was aware of [REDACTED] age due to him responding to service calls involving [REDACTED]. Browder made the following admissions concerning his texting with [REDACTED], a [REDACTED]

- He asked [REDACTED] to become friends on Snapchat (a texting software application)
- Sending [REDACTED] pictures and messages via Snapchat. Including a picture of him without his shirt on and it was only of his torso up.
- Asking [REDACTED] to sneak out to meet with him.
- His actions were provocative with this minor child.
- Apologized for ever having doing so in the first place.
- "I accept full responsibility for this and do apologize if I have left anything out."
- "I made this mistake and that I know it was stupid. By me saying it was stupid I am stating that I know better than this."

Browder denied sending [REDACTED] any pictures or videos of him being nude or specifically of his genitals. He also denied that [REDACTED] had sent him such pictures or videos. Additionally, Browder stated he thought it was weird [REDACTED] was saving their messages (due to function of Snapchat), and asked [REDACTED] about it. He then proceeded to ask [REDACTED] to delete their messages, and [REDACTED] did delete them except for the one of him asking [REDACTED] to sneak out to meet him. Browder described his actions with this under age minor as "provocative." He elaborated that he meant "... I had been provocative in sending pictures of myself and messaging her." "... I am a 24 year old sheriff's deputy and I sent messages and non-sexually explicit photos of myself to a [REDACTED]"

He also denied going by [REDACTED] house after asking [REDACTED] to sneak out to meet him. Additionally, Browder stated he has never been to [REDACTED] house off-duty or when not directed to do so such as, a service call. He denied sending any sexually explicit texts or pictures to anyone under the age of 18. According to Browder, his last communication with [REDACTED] was on Monday, November 6th.

Browder voluntarily consented to allow his personal cell phone to be downloaded, and advised that he routinely deletes his messages, emails, etc. from his cell phone. Investigator Phipps from LCSD Forensic Services Unit downloaded Browder's personal cell phone.


On Friday, December 1st, I received a report (Exhibit D) from Investigator Phipps. He also included copies of deleted text messages (Exhibit E) from Browder of a sexually oriented nature with what appears to an adult female while he was on-duty on 10.23.2017. The messages to indicate their desire to meet in the Swansea Area of Lexington County while Browder is working. Phipps advised that due to his actions of regularly deleting messages very little data is recoverable from the phone.

and according to [REDACTED] he has even asked the [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] could sneak out of the house to meet him. [REDACTED] informed me that [REDACTED] has saved the messages on Facebook Messenger and has also took a screenshot of the messages from Snapchat. Browder asked the [REDACTED] why [REDACTED] was taking screenshots of the messages and [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] always saves messages from [REDACTED] friends. [REDACTED] also stated that he has told [REDACTED] that he didn't want people knowing that they had been talking with [REDACTED]

The [REDACTED] has been forwarding screenshots of the messages to [REDACTED] I asked [REDACTED] to forward them to me. [REDACTED] asked if they should have [REDACTED] to send him a message asking him to stop contacting [REDACTED] I told [REDACTED] at this point not to inform him of anything so that we could open an investigation into these accusations. I asked [REDACTED] to have her [REDACTED] to continue sending the messages to her but to take a picture of the messages from Snapchat from another device so that Browder did not know that pictures were being taken of the messages.

I advised [REDACTED] that I would contact Solicitor David Stumbo regarding this information and that we would be in contact with the proper authorities.

I met with Deputy Browder again on Tuesday, December 5th regarding the report concerning his personal cell phone. Browder admitted the following concerning his text messaging and sexual activities while on-duty:

- While on calls for service he has texted others via multiple social media applications.
- While on-duty has sent and received sexually explicit or sexually inappropriate messages.
- Sent nude or explicit pictures of himself (some while he was in his LCSD uniform) to others while on-duty. Does not recall sending any videos.
- Received nude or explicit pictures of others while on-duty. Does not recall receiving any videos.
- Meeting individuals while on-duty after texting in a sexually explicit or inappropriate manner with them while on-duty.
- Meeting with the aforementioned individuals while on-duty, and engaging in sexual acts. Cannot recall the number of times this happen. Once it occurred roadside.
- Cannot recall when was the last time he met with while on-duty or uniform for sexual relations.

Browder advised none his actions involved persons who are under 18 years old. He also provided a statement (Exhibit F) to this additional information.

CONCLUSION

This investigation revealed that Deputy Charles A. Browder had been texting a [REDACTED] and sent [REDACTED] a "provocative" picture of himself. As well, Browder attempted to entice the minor to sneak out of [REDACTED] home to meet with him while he was on-duty; some of this incidents occurred in the early morning hours. There was no evidence discovered that either had actually met or sent sexually explicit images to one another. Browder admitted to the above, and stated it was a "mistake and it was stupid."

Additionally, during the course of this investigation it was discovered that Browder was texting in a sexually explicit or sexually inappropriate manner while on service calls. He admitted to the following concerning this activity: while on-duty he sent and received these text messages, which included nude or explicit photos of himself (some included him in uniform) and of the other party, meeting with individuals while on-duty and engaging sexual activities with them. Browder cannot recall how many times these events occurred, as well he cannot remember the last time such activities have taken place.

As result of the facts discovered during this investigation and Deputy Browder's admissions, there is a **SUSTAINED** finding for his violating *LCSD Policy 1.05 Code of Conduct*:

Conduct Unbecoming - No employee of the Department at any time, on-duty or off-duty, shall engage in any conduct or activity that may be unbecoming to the employee, the Sheriff, and/or the LCSD.

On October 25th, 2017, I, Investigator Chris Wilkie was contacted by a [REDACTED] via Facebook Messenger @ 14:35 the message read as follows:

Hello there, please call me when you have a few minutes, [REDACTED] I think there is a problem with a Lexington County Deputy and my [REDACTED] and I am not sure what to do about it. Thanks [REDACTED]

I, tried several times to call [REDACTED] but each time the call continued go to voicemail.

On October 26th, 2017 @ 17:39hrs [REDACTED] sent another message which reads as followed:

Hey Chris, [REDACTED] again really need to talk to you, we can chat on the phone or I can meet you at the Coffee Shop, let me know, things are getting very odd with this situation and I just need some help/guidance on how to proceed.

On October 27, 2017 at 08:53hrs I received the following message from [REDACTED]

Still trying to reach you

I responded back with back with my cell phone number a few minutes after receiving the last message.

On October 27, 2017 at 09:01hrs I attempted to call [REDACTED] but it went straight to voicemail.

09:07hrs I received a call from [REDACTED], this phone call lasted 7minutes. The following is overview of the conversation between myself, Inv. Chris Wilkie and [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] has a [REDACTED] who is [REDACTED] yrs old that lives in Lexington that has been contacted by a Lexington County Sheriff's Deputy by the name of Charles Browder. She stated that Browder had taken [REDACTED] and a few of [REDACTED] friend's home one day after an incident took place involving a stolen vehicle. Since that time Browder has been messaging the [REDACTED] through Facebook messenger and has also been sending [REDACTED] messages on Snapchat. According to [REDACTED] initially the conversations were just casual. Now he has sent [REDACTED] messages asking for [REDACTED] to meet up with him

On 07/02/2017 I responded to 5228 Hwy 321, Gaston SC in the county of Lexington in reference a larceny of a motor vehicle.

Upon arrival I spoke with the caller Victoria Sweat who stated she was located at 5211 Hwy 321 at the Burger King when she heard several teenagers yelling inside the store and all ran outside. She stated they were yelling because someone had stolen their truck that was at the gas pump at this location. Victoria then stated they all saw an individual waving a gun in the air in the parking lot and she had them all get in her vehicle and moved them to the Wendy's at 5228 Hwy 321. Victoria stated she does not know any of the teenagers, nor did she see anyone take the truck.

I then spoke with Christopher Garvin, the driver of the vehicle. He stated the vehicle is his, but it is registered in his grandfathers name, Charles Peele. Christopher could not recall the tag or VIN for the red 2007 Dodge Ram 1500. The DMV also did not have anything listed for Charles Peele owning that vehicle. Christopher advised me that the Stated he had been driving the truck for two years. Truck is very loud, has a large antenna, tag lights are blue. Back right fender is broken. Has the phrase "Strokin" written down left side of windshield. The phrase "Peele boy Kennels" is in the middle back glass. Also as stated by the victim it has large tires.

Four other parties were on scene. [REDACTED] Steven Trayler, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was in the bed of the truck when the truck was stolen. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] tapped on the glass when [REDACTED] realized it was no longer Christopher driving the truck. The subject driving the vehicle pulled over at 5468 Bluff Rd in Richland County and pointed a firearm at [REDACTED] and told [REDACTED] to get out. [REDACTED] was then picked up by a Richland County deputy, and then I picked [REDACTED] up at 2015 Bluff Rd and brought him back to 5228 Hwy 321. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] only saw that it was a black male with a full beard and possibly a fade style haircut.

[REDACTED] Steven, [REDACTED] and Christopher stated they did not see anyone get into his truck, only saw the truck leaving the parking lot of 5221 Hwy 321 and was headed towards Columbia. Richland County was advised of this incident and to be on the lookout for this vehicle and to notify LCSD if any contact is made.

Christopher was advised of his case number. He informed me that he wants LCSD to contact his grandfather Charles Peele at 803-514-0163 if anyone locates the vehicle. Christopher, Steven, and [REDACTED] were escorted to 114 Graball Rd, Swansea, SC. [REDACTED] were escorted to 301 Goldentree Ct, Gaston SC due to being [REDACTED]

The vehicle was left running at the gas pump unattended.

Due to no tag or VIN given or unable to be located the vehicle was unable to be entered into NCIC.

Please take note that allegations have been made against you which has resulted in the initiation of an internal affairs investigation. *The accusation is you have exhibited conduct unbecoming of a Lexington County Sheriff's Department Deputy.*

You are further advised that, pursuant to Garrity vs. New Jersey, 385 U.S. 493 (1967), you are compelled to give a statement and answer questions relating to these matters. You have the option to not cooperate, or give a statement, however such refusal may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination.

Garrity states, in part, that public employees are citizens and therefore, guaranteed all rights provided by federal and state law to include due process and the Fifth Amendment right not to testify against one's self. As a result, any information discovered or revealed under Garrity cannot be used against you in a criminal matter.

Further, you are not to discuss this investigation and / or the underlying facts with members of this department or anyone else who is now or may become a subject or witness in this matter as such would likely jeopardize this investigation.

I Charles Allen Browder on 11/08/2017 give this statement voluntarily in reference to communications with [REDACTED]

I first had contact with [REDACTED] on a service call in June I believe at the Burger King on Hwy 321 in reference to [REDACTED] friend's truck being stolen. There were five individuals involved in the incident. [REDACTED] was one however I was not acquainted with [REDACTED] at this time as I was just getting information involved in serious crime that had just been committed. One of the individuals involved was still in the bed of the truck when the truck was stolen and I went and picked [REDACTED] up in Richland County right at the truck stop on Bluff Rd. I advised [REDACTED] and all of [REDACTED] friends to remain stationary at the new location we were gathering info from and that was the Wendy's across the highway from the burger king. I transported the [REDACTED] back to this location to find the four of them gone and due to the time of night and that they no longer had a vehicle I was going to give them all a ride to a safe location. [REDACTED]'s three male friends advised they had a house they could go to in Gaston off of Blackville road I believe but Master Deputy Wilkes transported them and I transported [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] friend to [REDACTED]'s house. I advised [REDACTED] of the address I was going to and that I had two [REDACTED] in the vehicle with me and I gave their age as well. I transported them to the home with beginning mileage which at that point was from the IGA on Hwy 321 going into Gaston and ending mileage at [REDACTED]'s house, which upon arrival to the street I was told I could just drop them off at the end of the street because [REDACTED] brother was on the roadway and they could just walk from there. I then left that location and cleared with having a report from this entire incident.

After a few weeks had passed, I am unsure of the exact date I received a call for service for a runaway child that being [REDACTED] from her parents. I arrived at their residence and they advised me of everything going on and that [REDACTED] had not been home for several days. Her parents had tried calling [REDACTED] several times and could not get a hold of [REDACTED] I then tried making contact via telephone and was unable to make contact. [REDACTED] parents advised that they would continue trying and they believed [REDACTED] was just out with [REDACTED] friends and [REDACTED] would go to school with them the following day. I then left the scene and advised them to contact the sheriff's department if [REDACTED] returns. They later called and I arrived to the scene and discussed with [REDACTED] as to why [REDACTED] thought it was okay to go missing for several days. I advised [REDACTED] that I would continue to check in on [REDACTED] and to have [REDACTED] parents call if they ever needed anything. I left the scene. I am unsure at this time if I did a report or not as I believe [REDACTED] parents did not ever request a report, only to try and locate [REDACTED]

I am unsure of the time frame but I realized afterwards that I was friends with [REDACTED] on facebook. A few weeks after that I received a new friend request from [REDACTED] from what appeared to be a new profile that [REDACTED] had created. I then messaged [REDACTED] stating "we can't be friends on here lol" and then I advised [REDACTED] I was a cop and that I knew who [REDACTED] was. I believe [REDACTED] later said "oh okay" and the [REDACTED] was sorry for sending the request, I advised [REDACTED] it was okay and that if [REDACTED] ever needed anything to let me know. For a few weeks we would message on and off and I would let [REDACTED] know where I was and what I

was doing while at work. Sometime during that time period I asked [REDACTED] if she had a snap chat and [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] did and we then became friends on snapchat. For another few weeks up until October 26th I had been in contact with [REDACTED] via snapchat sending pictures and texts through the app. I once sent a saved picture on my phone that was of me without a shirt on from the torso up. I also asked [REDACTED] on the app if [REDACTED] was "able to sneak out a minute" and [REDACTED] asked why and I said never mind. Throughout those few weeks I would ask if we could see each other but never went in to further detail than that. I never sent any explicit or nude photos of myself or of my genitalia. I did proceed to ask [REDACTED] one day through the snapchat message as to why [REDACTED] was saving the messages and that I thought it was weird due to the purpose of snapchat. I believe then I asked [REDACTED] to delete the messages and [REDACTED] did except for one which is the one of me asking [REDACTED] if she could sneak out a minute. The last message on snapchat that was either sent or received was on October 26th. [REDACTED] also never sent any pictures of [REDACTED] back that were explicit in any way and no nude pictures as well. Any pictures I would receive would be of [REDACTED] fully clothed or of something [REDACTED] was taking a picture of away from [REDACTED]. Pictures [REDACTED] sent to me would sometimes be directed to me but others were as if [REDACTED] sent this one picture to several people in [REDACTED] friends list on the snapchat app. I mentioned I would message [REDACTED] while at work, also off duty I would as well but not as much.

The last contact I had with [REDACTED] was via facebook messenger on November 6th in the evening time around 7 or 8pm, I can't recall but it was before I had went to sleep. I received an "invite to messenger" request from [REDACTED] as I believe my facebook had malfunctioned when I updated the app. I then responded with "how are you doing" and just a few messages back and forth of "that's good, im glad you're doing well". I can't recall exactly what I had said as I had deleted the messages.

I have only come into physical contact with [REDACTED] twice. And I have been in the vicinity of [REDACTED] neighborhood three times. I do recall that I go down [REDACTED] quite a bit for calls for service and other roads close to there but not to [REDACTED] neighborhood specifically. I have since tried to keep a professional attitude with [REDACTED] and I understand the severity of even talking to [REDACTED] to begin with. At first I thought I was being nice and making sure [REDACTED] stays on track while now I know I am only part of the problem and I took it past professionalism and have not done what a sheriff's deputy should be doing. I knew that I had been provocative in sending pictures of myself and messaging [REDACTED]. What I mean by being provocative is that I am a 24 year old sheriff's deputy and I sent messages and non-sexually explicit photos of myself to a [REDACTED]. I accept full responsibility for this and do apologize if I have left anything out. I can't express that enough, If I don't know, I just don't know. But I do know I am supposed to remember these things and that I should have known better. I never visited [REDACTED] neighborhood in my personal vehicle either or saw her while off duty.

I am unsure of exact dates and times on some of the incidents I have listed above. I know of the last date on snapchat as I have the app on my phone today and was able to see the last date. On Facebook

messenger I have deleted all messages and I never sent any pictures via facebook messenger. I do not have [REDACTED] phone number either. Facebook messenger and Snapchat were the only two ways I communicated with [REDACTED] and I apologize for ever having doing so in the first place. I have told no one else about this. I kept it to myself.

I have never had any sexually explicit conversations or sent any sexually explicit photos to [REDACTED] Nor have I sent any sexually explicit photos to anyone under the age of 18.

I asked [REDACTED] once to step outside of [REDACTED] house once. I never told [REDACTED] a location to go to or an address. I do not remember the time of day this conversation occurred.

I stated that I made this mistake and that I know it was stupid. By me saying it was stupid I am stating that I know better than this. Boredom took over when these messages would be sent, I should have never sent anything to begin with and the stupidity began when I even messaged [REDACTED] saying we can't be friends on facebook and it then further turned into myself messaging [REDACTED] afterwards, even up until November 6th.

I have never done anything of a sexually explicit nature with anyone under the age of 18 since I have been a deputy sheriff.

Yes I have received explicit pictures while on duty. I can not recall any videos at this time.

Have you ever while on-duty met with anyone after chatting either telephonically or by text message in a sexually explicit or inappropriate manner?

Yes I have. I met with this person once to the best of my ability. I do not remember as it has been a while. The amount of times Ive met with someone I cannot recall at this time since it has been a while.

Have you ever engaged in any sexual acts while on-duty or off-duty and in your LCSD uniform, as the result of the above type of communications?

I have engaged in sexual acts while on duty. It occurred roadside. Not in my county vehicle. It occurred once while on duty to the best of my knowledge as it has been a while.

Is there anything else to disclose you know or believe would or could be important to this Internal Affairs investigation?







ISSUES

Chief Shockley advised there was possibly a video on social media (Facebook) of an unknown Deputy exhibiting unprofessional conduct. He further stated that Major Matt Davis with the Lexington Police Department had initially received the information. As a result, this investigation was initiated.

INVESTIGATIVE FINDINGS

On Sunday, December 3, 2017, I spoke with Major Matt Davis and learned that incident took place at [REDACTED] in Gaston. He advised he would forward me the video link he had received along with the complainant's name and telephone number.

Upon reviewing the video (**Exhibit A**), I was unable to confirm the identity of the Deputy in question. As a result, I contacted Master Deputy Jason Wilkes, the on-duty supervisor, and learned that Deputy Charles A. Browder had responded to the address on Friday, December 1st. I instructed MD Wilkes to have Deputy Browder meet me at the Professional Standards Division office ASAP.

The video shows Deputy Browder using profane words and phrases (fuck," "fucking," "damn," "shit," etc.) while speaking with a female during a service call concerning her threatening to kill herself with a firearm. The video lasts for nearly 4 minutes. The Deputy, who was identified as Charles A. Browder, was also very unprofessional during the call. He makes belittling and degrading comments laced with profanity while discussing her marital situation, mental health, and her actions during the video. Additionally, Browder makes comparisons to his personal life and actions to the female's life. He also complains to the female that this is third domestic call and he has only been at two and half hours.

On Sunday, December 3rd, I interviewed Deputy Charles A. Browder, under Garrity (**Attachment A**), and he provided a statement (**Exhibit B**). Deputy Browder advised that he had "lost his temper" while dealing with the female half (later identified as [REDACTED]). He further stated that he did use profanity (words such as "fuck," "fucking," "damn," "shit," etc.) while having a heated and terse "argument" with Rabon at the call for service. Browder described his actions as follows:

- "I blew up on her on yesterday as if I had a part in her life, as if I was the one that was going to have live with her or take care of her kids."
- "I became too involved."
- "... I want to apologize to [REDACTED] for doing that."

After the interview, Deputy Browder was shown the video that recorded his interactions with [REDACTED]



CONCLUSION

On Friday, December 1st at approximately 0800hrs, Deputy Charles A. Browder responded to a call for service at [REDACTED] in the Gaston/Swansea area for Lexington County, which entailed a female ([REDACTED]) threatening to kill herself with a firearm stemming from ongoing domestic issues, and her children were present. [REDACTED] recorded Browder's actions with her cell phone. During the service call, Browder's interactions with [REDACTED] become agitated raising his voice to the point of yelling at her, using profanity (words such as "fuck," "fucking," "damn," "shit," etc.), as well as, belittling and degrading about her mental health and current marital situation. The video clearly captures these unprofessional actions of Deputy Browder, which he admitted to doing the above acts prior to seeing the video. He advised the following in describing his actions: his lost temper, blew up on her, and became too involved.


As result of the facts discovered during this investigation and Deputy Browder's admission to exhibiting unprofessional behavior during a service call, there is a **SUSTAINED** finding for his violating *LCSD Policy 1.05 Code of Conduct*:

Conduct Unbecoming - No employee of the Department at any time, on-duty or off-duty, shall engage in any conduct or activity that may be unbecoming to the employee, the Sheriff, and/or the LCSD.

Treatment of Persons in the Performance of Duty - Employees of the Department should always be civil and courteous when dealing with the public. Employees should avoid using profane language, and should answer questions carefully and courteously.

On 12/01/2017 I responded to [REDACTED] Swansea, SC in the county of Lexington in reference to an female with a firearm stating she was going to kill herself.

I responded Code 3 to the scene from Gaston due to a firearm possibly being present and there being children on scene. On the way to the scene there was heavy traffic and I became very flustered with vehicles not slowing down or moving over to let myself and Deputy Cain through.

I arrived on scene at approximately 0800hrs, I am unsure of the exact time. Upon arrival I stepped out of my vehicle and was unable to locate anyone with a firearm. However, my firearm was drawn and my heart was racing due to there possibly being a gun involved. We were then able to make contact with the caller Mr. [REDACTED] who stated the female, his wife Ms. [REDACTED] was inside on the couch. We asked him to have her step outside. Mr. [REDACTED] did advise us that the firearm was no where to be found and he has no idea what she did with it. Mrs. [REDACTED] then stepped out onto the porch and I asked her to step down on the ground away from the three children inside the home and Mr. [REDACTED] due to her actions that were portrayed via dispatch and that she may have suicidal tendencies. Mrs. [REDACTED] refused to go down the steps so I placed my hand on her arm and made the motion for her to move. She then said let go of me and I will go down the steps. I let go of her and she went down the steps.

I then asked Mrs. [REDACTED] where the gun was and she stated she did not know. She began asking me if I should believe her husband and that she insisted he was lying. Mrs. [REDACTED] did state to me while on the porch that she has had suicidal tendencies in the past. With Mr. [REDACTED] making claims that she stated she was going to kill herself with his firearm EMS was contacted. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he had turned her phone off and that is why she was going to kill herself.

I then got into a verbal argument with Mrs. [REDACTED] on why I was there. I began swearing at her and blaming her for multiple things. I did this because of her attitude and I let her get to me and act a way that I should not have. It was unprofessional. I became very angry that a mother of three with no job would end her life over a cell phone being turned off. I became way too involved in this incident and I did use words like "fuck" and "damn" and other cuss words. I have two children myself that I work so hard for and would never do something as child as this. My anger got to me which used to be a major problem in my life growing up and coming through college. I blew up on her on something that I should have had no part in. I still get angry at certain things on duty, but I do my best to hide that and act professional towards the people im out with. Mrs. [REDACTED] got to me. The involvement of a firearm, unable to locate the female when arriving on scene, and the code run down there worked me up and I let it out on her when I should not have.

I asked her why she doesn't have a job, why she would do such a thing like end her life, and I stated that due to her suicidal tendencies in the past she will continue to have them. I am not a medical professional and I should have never said something like that to her. Unfortunately it was all caught on video and I do understand the consequences of that. It's no different than wearing a body cam which I have done in the past at the previous law enforcement agency I worked at. I never let people get to me while im on scene and I blew up on her yesterday as if I had a part in her life, as if I was the one that was

going to have live with her or take care of her kids. I became too involved. Im sorry for doing so and I want to apologize to Mrs. [REDACTED] for doing that.

Mrs. [REDACTED] was transported by EMS to the hospital to be further evaluated for her suicidal statements. I then stayed on scene and gathered the information on the missing firearm. I advised Mr. [REDACTED] of his case number and then cleared the scene.

[REDACTED] stated he has been unable to locate the firearm, [REDACTED] stated several times that [REDACTED] had the firearm and that she said she would give him the gun back if he turns her cellphone back on.

[REDACTED] stated that she has no idea where the gun is and that [REDACTED] is making all of this up. She also stated to myself and Deputy Cain that she has had suicidal threats in the past due to depression. EMS was notified and transported [REDACTED] to the Lexington Medical Center for further evaluation.

The Smith and Wesson firearm has not been located as of yet. [REDACTED] stated he does not believe anyone has stolen the weapon. The firearm is a .40 caliber and has a serial number of FWV4632. I advised [REDACTED] of this case number in reference to this incident.

ISSUES

On February 8, 2018, I received a copy of a handwritten complaint from Inmate David Lamson alleging during his arrest by Lexington County Sheriff's Department (LCSD) Deputies Charles Browder and Chris Burnett on May 28, 2017, they assaulted him, took his eyeglasses, and never returned them. Upon receipt of this complaint (**Exhibit A**) an Internal Affairs investigation was initiated.

As I read LCSD Incident Report #17010355 (**Exhibit B**) which occurred on May 27, 2017, Deputy Chris Burnett utilized Defensive Tactics techniques were being referred to as an assault. In the report, Burnett describes his attempt to initiate a traffic stop, but the driver of the vehicle, David Lamson, escalated to an attempt to flee law enforcement. After a brief pursuit, Lamson exited the vehicle and led Deputies Burnett and Charles Browder on a foot pursuit. Lamson was apprehended by Browder near a locked fence, and was given loud verbal commands to get on the ground, however, he refused. Lamson was advised that he was under arrest. Lamson, again attempted to walk away from Deputies, but Burnett grabbed his left arm to escort him to the ground, but Lamson still refused to comply with the Deputies. Finally, Lamson was taken to the ground, but both Deputies were still tussling with Lamson. They had to grab his hands, place them behind his back in order to handcuff him. At no point did they punch Lamson with their fist or strike him.

As Lamson was being escorted to the patrol vehicle, he told Burnett that he had "something in his foot." Lamson was not wearing shoes when he fled, and Burnett could see an object sticking out of bottom of Lamson's foot. Burnett called EMS to the scene, but they could not remove the item. Therefore, EMS transported Lamson to Lexington Medical Center (LMC) where he was examined, and the object was removed from his foot. After he was released, Lamson was transported to Lexington County Detention Center (LCDC) to be booked for several traffic offenses.

On March 6, 2018, I checked with EMS to find out if Lamson left any eye glasses in the ambulance during his transport to LMC. After checking their records, there was no indication of eyewear being left in the ambulance. I was also advised that after each transport to a medical facility, the EMS crew checks the ambulance, cleans it, and restocks their supplies. There were no items left behind by the patient on May 27, 2018.

I called LMC Emergency Room to inquire if they possibly had a lost and found section for articles left behind in the ER. I was transferred to the number for the Action Line. I left a message for a return call.



On March 6, 2018, I called LCDC Sergeant Eliza Davis, to have her to check the Booking sheet for Lamson in order to find out if he had glasses when he was booked in LCDC. Immediately after looking at Lamson's booking information, Davis remembered that Lamson did not have eyeglasses when he came to the facility. However, Davis stated Correct Care Solutions (CCS) sent Lamson to the ophthalmologist, and purchased prescription eyeglasses for him. I called the Health Services Administrator with CCS, Lena Starks on April 25, 2018, to confirm the purchase. Starks stated Lamson was sent to the ophthalmologist for eye examination and eyeglasses. Starks stated during December, 2017, Lamson received his new pair of eyeglasses that were purchased by CCS.

On March 7, 2018, I interviewed Sergeant Adam Spires, and he was given Garrity Warning (Attachment A). Spires remembered some of the circumstances involving the arrest of Lamson. However, Spires stated the male was in his vehicle for transport from LMC to LCDC for the booking process. Spires stated he did not have any property that belonged to Lamson during the time of the arrest, the transport process, nor during this investigation. Spires added he did not remember any Deputy stating that they had Lamson's eyeglasses. Spires stated he had contact with Lamson sometime after the arrest. Lamson approached him while they were in Swansea Magistrate's Court about missing eyeglasses, and at that time Spires advised Lamson of the complaint process. Spires provided a statement (Exhibit C) of the information he gave during his interview.

On March 12, 2018, I interviewed Deputy Chris Burnett, and he was given Garrity Warning (Attachment B). Burnett stated he remembered a vehicle pursuit involving Lamson in a Ford F-150. After the pursuit, Lamson exited the vehicle in an attempt to flee on foot. According to Burnett, Lamson failed to comply with the loud verbal commands, and when officers captured him, they ran into a fence along with Lamson, but then were able to escort him down to the ground. Lamson continued to resist, but was successfully handcuffed and arrested without further incidents. Burnett remembered seeing Lamson's glasses lying on the ground. Burnett stated, "The glasses were picked up and either placed with him prior to being transported by EMS or placed inside his vehicle which was towed." Browder was the assisting Deputy on the scene with Burnett. Burnett prepared a statement (Exhibit D) of the information he provided.

I am unable to interview Deputy Charles Browder due to the fact that he is no longer employed by the Lexington County Sheriff's Department.

CONCLUSION

On February 8, 2018, I received a copy of a handwritten complaint from Inmate David Lamson alleging during his arrest by Lexington County Sheriff's Department (LCSD) Deputies Charles Browder and Chris Burnett on May 28, 2017, they assaulted him, took his eyeglasses, and never returned them.

During the course of this investigation, it was revealed through statements and interviews, that while Deputies Chris Burnett and Charles Browder were attempting to effect the arrest of David Lamson, he led Deputies on a vehicle and foot pursuit. Lamson was fleeing and attempting to resist arrest, which resulted in him being taken down to the ground during the handcuffing process. Lamson only sustained an injury to his foot because while he was running without shoes, he stepped on a piece of wood, and the object was lodged in his foot.


Therefore, there is an EXONERATED finding for Deputies Chris Burnett and Charles Browder for *Assault* because the actions they used to effect an arrest was reasonable, lawful, and proper.


Also, there is a NOT SUSTAINED finding for Sergeant Adam Spires, Deputies Chris Burnett and Charles Browder for *Lost Property*, because the eyeglasses were either given to David Lamson prior to

transport by EMS, or placed in his vehicle. Also, CCS replaced the eyeglasses at no cost to Lamson in December, 2017.



On 05/27/2017 at approximately 10:00PM, Deputy Browder and I responded to the Dollar General, 185 North Main St, located in the Gaston area of Lexington County, in reference to a suspicious vehicle.

Upon arrival I observed the vehicle to be an older model Ford F-150 as stated by the caller. As we pulled into the Dollar General, the vehicle turned on it's headlights and began to leave turning right onto N. Main St toward Mack St.

We turned onto Mack St and got behind the vehicle. Deputy Browder ran the SC tag (MWV601) displayed on the vehicle and dispatch advised it came back to a BMW. At this time we initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle for this violation. We turned on our blue emergency lights at Meadowfield Rd at Blackville Rd. The vehicle continued on Meadowfield Rd, increasing its speed from 45MPH to 85MPH.

We advised dispatch the vehicle was initiating a pursuit at this time. MD Franklin advised he was monitoring. The vehicle continued speeds around 84MPH in 45MPH. The vehicle crossed left of center multiple times but there wasn't any traffic coming in the opposite direction. The driver tossed a large glass bottle out of the driverside window which shattered on the roadway and splashed an unknown liquid on our window. We approached the traffic circle on Meadowfield Rd at Sharpes Hill Rd. The vehicle quickly turned left, driving over the median and into the opposite direction of traffic however no vehicles were in the area at this time. We continued onto Sharpes Hill Rd where we reached speeds around 55MPH in 45MPH. We turned right onto Long Spires Rd and continued around 55MPH in 35MPH.

I knew Long Spires Rd stopped at Mimosa Rd so I advised Deputy Browder to slow down and put more space between our vehicles. The vehicle approached the stop sign on Long Spires Rd and attempted to stop however it continued through the stop sign and across Mimosa Rd. The vehicle came to a final stop just across the street prior to striking a telephone pole. I observed the driver, David Lamson, exit the vehicle and flee on foot. Deputy Browder came in contact with David near a locked fence. Deputy Browder gave him loud verbal commands to get on the ground however he refused. David began to walk away from Deputy Browder as I ran over.

David repeatedly ignored our commands to stop and get on the ground. I grabbed his left arm and attempted to escort him to the ground however he still refused. I grabbed the back of David's head and escorted him to ground. While on the ground David refused to place his hands behind his back. I was able to grab his hands and place them in the small of his back which were handcuffed. David was told he was under arrest. The handcuffs were double locked and he was searched incident to arrest.

We walked David back to our vehicle where he stated he had something in his foot. I did observe what appeared to be a piece of something stuck in the bottom of his foot. David was not wearing shoes while he fled on foot. EMS was called to the scene. EMS could not retrieve the item from his foot so they transported him to LMC. Sgt Spires followed behind EMS to LMC. LMC removed the item from his foot and Sgt Spires transported him to LCDC where he was booked in.

David is being charges with failure to stop for blue lights, improper vehicle registration plate, suspended registration plate, littering and driving under suspension 1st offense.

On March 6th, 2018, I received a call from Sergeant Cathy Etheridge of the Professional Standards Division. Sgt Etheridge asked if I had found any glasses in my patrol vehicle. I told her no. It almost immediately dawned on me that this was a complaint from a gentleman that had spoken to me about his missing glasses a few months earlier. I asked Sgt Etheridge if this was a complaint from a person that Deputy Chris Burnett arrested. She confirmed it was. I told her he spoke to me at court (Swansea Magistrate) a few months ago and asked about his missing glasses. He told me at the time that Deputy Burnett and his trainee at the time (I don't remember who it was) said they didn't have his glasses. I told him I did not have his glasses. I told Sgt Etheridge that I told him how to file a formal complaint. I also told Sgt Etheridge that I didn't believe he was ever in my vehicle and I never had his glasses.

I later thought about it and believe he was in my vehicle. After he was captured in a foot chase that came on the heels of a vehicle pursuit, he went to the hospital with a thorn in his foot that a doctor had to remove. I believe I then transported him to LCDC from the hospital. I was being truthful with Sgt Etheridge, I simply did not remember the particulars of the incident due to it being months ago. I still do not know the gentleman's name nor do I know the case number. I believe he was a white male approximately in his late 40's that was about 5'06".

I do not have any knowledge of where his glasses went on the night of the incident. I have no knowledge of any Deputy taking his glasses.

I also believe he complained to me about the manner in which he was captured by deputies. He alleged excessive force and said he was pushed into a fence. Deputies on scene told me this was during the foot chase and they pushed him into the fence to gain control of him. Based on the totality of circumstances, I saw no evidence of excessive force and there was no violation of policy, as pertains to the excessive force.


