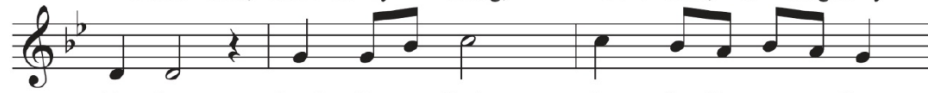

PROFESSION OF FAITH



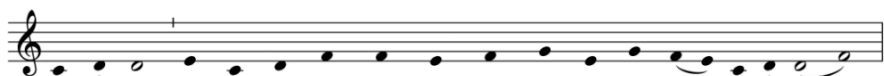
