BACKGROUND

Rahmani Program of Excellence was established in the wake of the Sachar Committee report, on the condition of Muslims in India, which was commissioned by the then Prime Minister of India Dr. Manmohan Singh.

This extensive report highlighted that the systemic discrimination of the Muslim community has pushed it to being the most backward community in India behind even the scheduled castes and tribes, previously known as untouchables. A wide gap exists between the national average and the Muslim community in terms of access to education, sanitary living conditions, clean drinking water, and wealth, to name a few.

The following are some of the highlights from the report:

- Muslims have the highest dropout rates at all levels of schooling
- Almost half of the children aged 6-12 years are not currently attending school
- Only 17% of Muslim students above the age of 17 years have completed 10th grade education
- Only 3.4% of students earning a Bachelor's degree are Muslims
- Only ~3.5% of Muslim students attend Madrasa systems
- Institutes of National Importance ~1% to 4%
- Indian Institute of Management ~1%
- Union Public Service Commission ~ 3%

The govt. of India, by the act of parliament, identifies institutions that are considered vital for the continued success of the country. These are one hundred and thirty-eight institutions out of some nine hundred institutions and cater to around 3% of students while receiving a disproportionate funding of 51% of the total higher education funding. In the backdrop of the Sachar Committee Report, the leadership team of Hazrat Maulana Mohammad Wali Rahmani sahib designed several educational initiatives to change the condition of the community. Rahmani30 is the most prominent effort under the umbrella of Rahmani Program of Excellence initiatives. It is a concept that seeks to create a partnership with students, within the Islamic constructs, to develop moral leadership capacity and prepare them to be successful at the toughest undergraduate examinations in the world, such as the Advanced Joint Entrance Examination and others.

STUDENT SELECTION METHODOLOGY

Rahmani30 started with 10 students and now it has 806 students in four different cities. We are blessed with great donors who appreciate the value of this work. Over the past years we have cultivated student body across India and now we receive applications in excess of tens of thousands per year. Unfortunately, however we remain severely constrained with our funding and therefore we have instituted a selection process to identify students who have a more developed sense of moral purpose, consistency in approach, and willingness to learn. The following are the three-steps of this process:

- ❖ **STEP 1 - GENERAL MULTIPLE-CHOICE TEST:** This is open to all students currently in their 10th grade. More than 330 institutions across India participate in this process.
- ❖ **STEP 2 - SUBJECTIVE ASSESSMENT:** Successful students in step one are then invited to participate in the step two of the process.
- ❖ **STEP 3 - INTERVIEW:** – Successful students in step two undergo a behavioral interview process.

LEARNING METHODOLOGY & THE ENGAGEMENT MODEL

Learning methodology, student engagement model and Islamic environment are the foundations upon which students exert their efforts to achieve great success. Rahmani30's learning methodology seeks to empower students to become learners, thinkers, and problem-solvers as opposed to rote memorization of facts, figures, and formulas. During the two years, students develop collaboration, teamwork, and leadership skill-sets. The focus on the development of Islamic Identity, character building, and understanding of the deen develops the moral compass that will help students prepare for this world and the hereafter.

Rahmani30 engages students as responsible partners for creating success. We view that the community and the broader society is the beneficiary of the program rather than the students. Our students are mentored by Subject Matter Experts in both sciences as well as Islamic sciences. Rahmani30 has also instituted a program with leaders around the world to continue to mentor students in their journey after Rahmani30.

CURRENT STUDENT BODY

Alhamdulillah, we now support four streams of education under the banner of Rahmani30 - Engineering, Medicine, Commerce, and National Defence We currently have 806 students in the two-year program with the following distribution.

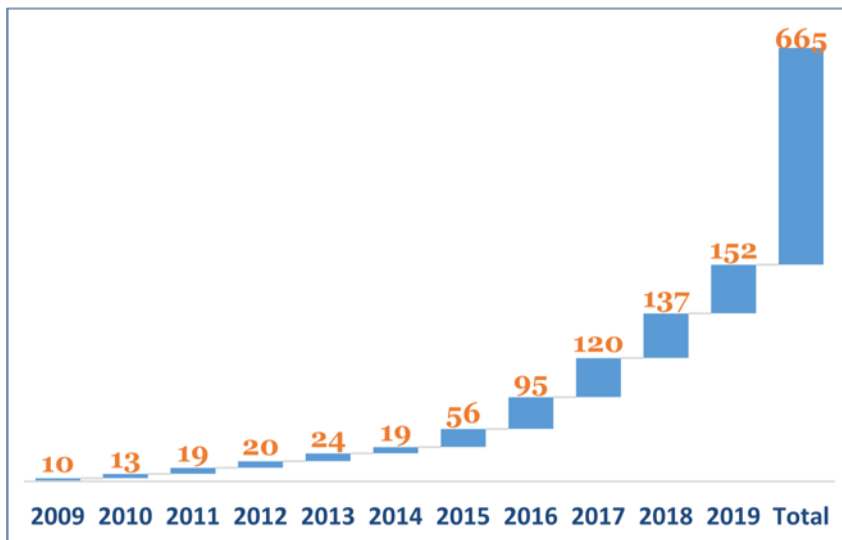
ENGINEERING | JEE-IIT ADVANCE RESULTS

Indian Institutes of Technology is the epitome of engineering universities in India and boasts the toughest undergraduate selection entrance examination in the world. Around 1.2 million students apply every year for approximately eleven thousand coveted seats in a two-step examination processes; the Joint Entrance Examination Mains (JEE-Mains) and then the JEE Advanced examination.



This year 43 out of 109 of our students, an astounding 38%, who took the Advanced level, qualified this examination. We must note that IIT reduced the number of students it qualifies by one third, which is reflected in our performance for the past two year.

ENGINEERING | JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS RESULTS



The government of India has centralized the selection process of the premier engineering universities. This is the exam that also qualifies students for top-tier universities including Institutes of National Importance such as the National Institute of Technology (NIT), the

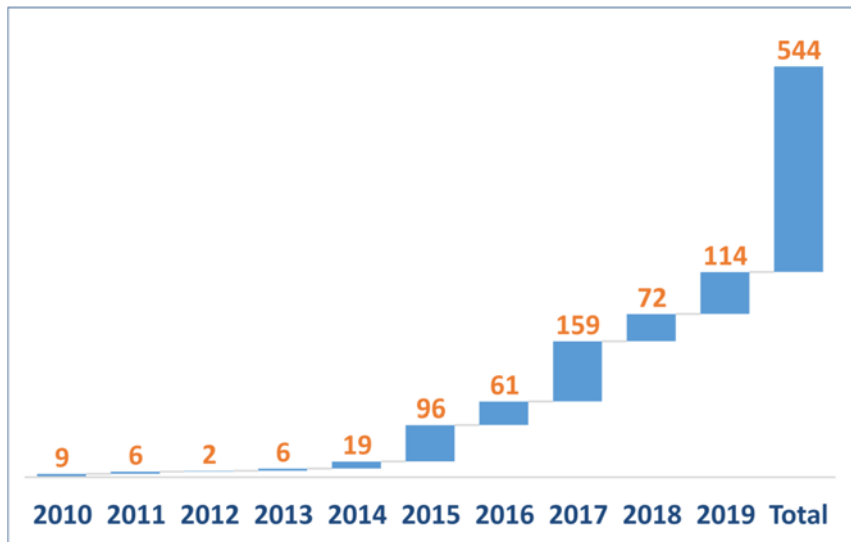
Indian Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) and the Indian Institutes of Sciences (IISc).

Alhamdulillah, Rahmani30 students have performed exceedingly well year over year. This year 152 of our students qualified in this examination. An amazing 93% of Engineering students qualified this exam and 20 of our Medical students were also successful.

ACADEMIC RESEARCH | OLYMPIAD RESULTS

The purpose of Olympiad is to identify and nurture young talents in the fields of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Astronomy. It is an international educational competition in which more than one hundred countries participate. Selection in the Olympiads is considered an epitome of achievements in the field of Sciences.

Alhamdulillah, in 2015, 48% of Olympians in the Bihar zone were from Rahmani30, with 96 qualifications overall. In 2018, 72 students were honored with the selection; also, Rahmani30



students achieved both the nominations in Astronomy for the zone. This year 42 out of 64 nominations in the 12th grade for the North zone were bagged by Rahmani30 students.

ACADEMIC RESEARCH | KVPY RESULTS

The Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana is a National Program of Fellowship in Basic or Pure Research in the Sciences. The Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, conducts KVPY talent search annually. Across India, highly focused and motivated students with a research bent of mind take part in this test. Top research institutes such as the Indian Institute of Sciences (IISc) recruit students directly based on this test. Alhamdulillah, three years in a row, two students have qualified annually in this exam, whereas initially in 2016, one of our students was successful.

MEDICAL | AIIMS & JIPMER RESULTS

The All India Institute of Medical Sciences is the quintessence of the medical institutions in India. Every year around four hundred thousand high performing students compete nationally for 807 seats in all nine branches of AIIMS, i.e., the organization extends admissions to a mere .002% of students. Last year, the first full batch of Rahmani30 students attempted this exam and alhamdulillah two students qualified and similarly two students qualified this year. This year we also achieved another milestone with qualification of one student at the Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education and Research, a premier medical university (JIPMER) that competes with AIIMS for the top rank.

MEDICAL | NEET RESULTS

In India, the best medical colleges are mostly publicly funded, and students are provided with almost free education if they are selected into these colleges. According to an estimate taxpayers' incur, on average, a cost of more than 50 lac rupees in training one Doctor of Medicine (MD); and in the case of AIIMS and JIPMER this cost is at least tripled.

Preparing students to be successful at the medical entrance exam is new for Rahmani30. However, by His ﷻ mercy, we have achieved a great deal over the last few years – alhamdulillah. We have consistently outperformed ourselves and the industry in almost every parameter. This year 100% of Rahmani30 students qualified the NEET (medical) exam and more than 16% of our students scored above 99th percentile. Note that the most successful medical preparation organization in the country, in terms of number of students, had 5% of its student above 99th percentile. This comparative analysis has emboldened us to further expand the program, alhamdulillah.

COMMERCE | ICAI COMMERCE WIZARD & NSE

There are currently 2.5 lakh trained Chartered Accountants (CA) in India whereas according to the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI), the economic activity requires more than 30 lakh trained CAs. Last year, an average salary of 7.36 lakhs were extended, in campus placements, to new graduates. Given this opportunity, Rahmani30 has ventured into preparation for the CA Foundation Course in addition to science streams. Alhamdulillah, in the last two years more than 60% of our students cleared this Foundation exam.

- ❖ **COMMERCE WIZARD EXAMINATION** is conducted annually by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India to identify potential talents in the commerce stream to incentivize their journey in this field. In 2017, 35 Muslims out of a total of 3286 students, were successful; alhamdulillah among them, 15 were Rahmani30 students. In 2018, 6 Muslim students were successful from the North zone and all of them were Rahmani30 students.
- ❖ **NATIONAL STOCK EXCHANGE FOUNDATION COURSE:** In order to broaden the scope of our students, the commerce stream now includes courses from the National Stock Exchange. These courses are usually taken after attaining an undergraduate degree in commerce. Alhamdulillah, in the last two years 100% of the students in the commerce stream were successful at this exam.
