## Parking Update

Hazel would like to thank all residents in the area who submitted feedback to the County Council regarding week-time parking by students and commuters parking in their streets. All homes affected should have been contacted and a scheme is now being worked up to allow the streets to be returned to residents only in the week days. This is result of several petitions to the County Council and pressure from Hazel to get this process going.

## Crossing Finished

Hazel is delighted that the crossing outside Blackbrook Pavillion is now fully operational. There had been some delay in getting the lights working due to Western Power being unwilling to do works until this year despite pressure from Hazel. They are now operational.



The crossing was initially granted after a successful bid for a Small Improvement Scheme by Hazel resulting in the County Council installing the crossing on Blackbrook Way. With increasing members of the public wanting to use the swimming pool, Hazel felt it was essential that a crossing be installed to allow pedestrians and cyclists safe passage to the site.

## Post Office

Danny and Derek would like to express disappointment at the (what now seems inevitable) move of the Post Office at Mountfields Road, run by the same Postmaster for 32 years, to Upper Holway Road.



The public consultation was a sham; done in a briefly with minimal publicity. Derek and Danny have formally complained and have a requested a longer and more publicised consultation. Residents deserve better.
