

Claims and casualties

The following list gives the combat claims by 11 Group fighter squadrons during the period 26th May to 3rd June 1940. It has been compiled from 11 Group's record of combats and casualties, and from squadron diaries. Both have certain inaccuracies in them and these have been amended here. Other information to make the list as accurate as possible has come from interviews with the men who were there and from the Ministry of Defence. It is not claimed as being 100% accurate even now and it must be remembered that the claims and credits are those which were made at the time in good faith by the pilots and squadrons who flew at Dunkirk.
