Be sure to have the hand signals down for both sets of drivers. Whoever is being towed needs to be extra cautious to make sure they're keeping the towing strap taught the wrong tug too many times could cause the strap to break. Be aware of your safety and take it slow as there is no need to hurry.

What documentation do I need?

It is necessary to have the title of your vehicle to be able to cash in on cars. Many places won't even take your vehicle unless they can prove that it's yours. DMV.org offers a site to help you find your title if you are struggling to locate it.

What happens to my vehicle when it has been being sold?

A junkyard is able to carefully get rid of and recycle all parts that can't be sold as-is. This entire recycling process is exciting, often with junkyards removing any valuable parts to resell them, and then smashed up the remainder.

What about my license plate?

Keep your license plate safe, it is registered for you and not the [car](#). You can transfer the license plate onto a different vehicle, if it is one you have. If not, you can go to the DMV and turn it in. Make sure to check your state for any special rules.

You can if you're skilled and are willing to spend some time. Even if your car isn't driving, you have some great parts on it. By taking these off and selling them separately, you'll get plenty more out of it than simply selling the whole car straight out.
