Background information:

Launched in 2017, <u>FIA Smart Cities</u> was created to contribute to the implementation of the UN New Urban Agenda by helping cities define new models for more sustainable urban mobility. Serving as a platform for knowledge generation and information exchange at the crossroads of Sport and Mobility, FIA Smart Cities is composed of three pillars: the FIA Smart Cities Forum, the FIA Smart Cities Award, and the FIA Smart Cities Global Start-up Contest.

<u>United Smart Cities (USC)</u> is the Global Smart City Platform accelerating the United Nations mission to transform city infrastructures to sustainable technologies. Co-Initiated in 2014 by the Organization for International Economic Relations (OiER) and the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE), USC is focused on helping the world reach the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals by speeding up the city transformation process.
