

The mischief makers

Note: this is a translation of a pattern made by <https://www.facebook.com/KawaiiTouchPeluches> which was in French. I translated with permission from the maker, of course.

This is a great pattern for using up scraps of yarn! They're very easy to make; here's a basic model and then it's up to you to have fun with them!

Materials:

Yarn scraps in different colours
Hook (3,5 mm or whatever suits your yarn)
6 mm eyes
A bit of felt for decoration
Stuffing

Body:

Round 1: Start with a magic ring. 6 sc into magic ring (6)

Round 2: inc 6 times (12)

Round 3: (sc, inc in next st) repeat 6 times (18)

Round 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times (24)

Round 5: (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times (30)

Round 6: sc in all 30 st (30)

Round 7: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times (36)

Round 8-18: sc in all 36 st (36)

Round 19: (4 sc, dec in next 2 st) repeat 6 times (30)

Round 20: (3 sc, dec in next 2 st) repeat 6 times (24)

Round 21: sc in all 24 st (24)

Round 22: (2 sc, dec in next 2 st) repeat 6 times (18)

Round 23: (1 sc, dec in next 2 st) repeat 6 times (12)

Round 24: dec in all st (6)

Add eyes and stuff when needed. You can change colour as you wish, around round 14.

Ears: (make 2)

Round 1: Start with a magic ring. 5 sc into magic ring. (5)

Round 2: 1 turning chain, inc in each st (10)

Round 3: 1 turning chain, (sc, inc in next st) repeat 5 times (15)

Embroider the face the way you like... Tada!
