Cookie policy

Use of Cookies

In order for this site to work properly and to improve your browsing experience, this page must store a small amount of data on your computer, or access these already stored data (so-called cookies files or "cookies"). Over 90% of all Internet pages use this practice, but according to the regulations of the Republic of Croatia and the European Union we are obliged to ask for your consent before saving the cookies. By using this website you agree to use 'cookies'. By blocking "cookies" you can still browse the page, but some of its features will not be available to you.

What is HTTP Cookie?

"Cookie" is a small set of data previously stored on your computer by the web site you visit. "Cookies" usually store your preferences, web site settings, such as your preferred language or address. Later, when you open the same web page again, the web browser sends back the "cookies" that belong to that page. This allows the page to display information tailored to your needs.

"Cookies" can store a wide range of data including personal information (such as your name or email address). However, this data can only be stored if you enable it - the web pages can not access the data if you haven't provided them access and can not access other files on your computer. The default activities of storing and sending "cookies" are not visible to you. However, you can change your Internet browser settings so that you can choose whether or not to approve or reject cookie requests, whether you want to delete stored cookies automatically when you close your web browser, etc.

How to disable Cookies?

By disabling "cookies" you decide whether to allow the "cookies" to be stored on your computer or not. "Cookies" settings can be controlled and configured in your web browser.

For information on cookie settings, select the internet browser you are using.

If you disable cookies, you will not be able to use some of the functionality on the web site.

What are session cookie?

Provisional "cookies" or "cookie" sessions are removed from your computer by closing your web browser. By using them, the web site stores temporary data such as items in the shopping cart.

What are persistent cookie?

Permanent or stored "cookies" remain on your computer even after you close the program - Internet browsers. By using them, the website stores information such as login name and password, so you do not have to sign in for each visit to specific pages. Permanent cookies will remain on your computer for days, months, even years (depending on the settings).

What are first-party cookies?

First party cookies come from the web site you are viewing, and may be permanent or temporary. Using these cookies, the web site can store the information that will be used again next time the user visits these pages and they improve user experience.

What are third-party cookies?

Third-party "cookies" come from commercials of third-party internet domains (such as pop-ups or other ads) that are on the web pages you're watching. With these cookies, different internet domains can track the use of the Internet for marketing purposes.

Does MyGuide.Holiday use cookies?

Yes, with the primary purpose of providing our web pages with better user experience and easier viewing of the data, so we can record your selections, registration information, and services as well as the region. We also use them to learn more about you, to track your use of the website and recommend products and services, or give recommendations.

What kind of cookies does MyGuide.Holiday use and why?

- Session cookies cookies that are removed from your computer after you close the Internet browser. Used for authorization purposes and temporary memory of user settings when viewing pages.
- Persistent cookies remain on your computer even after you close the program Internet browsers to remove it from the program or user itself. Permanent "cookies" are used to better understand user habits and to improve web pages according to the habits of a particular user. This information is anonymous no personal user information is stored, but only search engines or devices (such as IP addresses). These data are also not linked to other personal information that the user may have previously provided.

Are there any third-party cookies on MyGuide.Holiday?

There are several services that save a certain amount of "cookies" to the user. These "cookies" are not set up by this web site, but some serve the normal functioning of certain features that make it easier for users to access content.

Outside services are currently only used for measuring attendance. The web pages of MyGuide.Holiday use the Google Analytics Analytics metering service.
