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#### **GRANTEES**

Of the 137 eligible applicants, the following 14 artists and cultural practitioners have been selected to receive an AMA mobility grant:

- 1. Singer and songwriter **Yasmina Jhabli** traveling from Tangiers (Morocco) to Douala (Cameroon) to participate in the third edition of the *Escales Bantoo Fair* (May 16 to June 01, 2020).
- 2. Cultural operator **Israa Chaabani** will travel from Tangier (Morocco) to Douala (Cameroon) to participate in the third edition of the *Escales Bantoo Fair* (may 16 to june 01, 2020).
- 3. Photographer and director **Fatoumata Tioye Coulibaly** will travel from Bamako (Mali) to Dakar (Senegal) to make a film, as part of an artistic residency organized by *Kino Teranga* (march 13-30, 2020).




#### **SELECTION COMMITTEE**

## **STATISTICS**


We received applications from many countries (several of which are usually under-represented), all African regions and representing a wide variety of artistic disciplines. Here are some statistics on the 137eligible applicants:



1- Breakdown by gender



2- Breakdown by home region


## **DESTINATION REGION**



3- Breakdown by region of destination



4- Breakdown by professions









2- Breakdown by home region






