

SeArCH is the Periodic Table of the Elements game that tests your knowledge of the elemental symbols. Use SeArCH cards to study at your own pace or race against friends to see who is the true master of the elements!

Objective

The main objective of SeArCH is to correctly answer the word spelled out by the elemental symbols. For each correct answer guessed by the player, the more SeArCH cards he or she receives. In a multiple player game, the winner is crowned if the player has more SeArCH cards than their opponent.

Components

- 50 SeArCH Cards
- 2 Periodic Table of the Elements Cards
- 1 Answer Key Card
- 1 Periodic Table of the Elements Poster (dimension of poster is 8.5" x 11")


Setup & Play

One Player: Hold the front of the SeArCH card in your hand. Flip over the card once you've made a guess of the word.

Multiple Players: Have a judge (friend, parent or teacher) hold the front of the SeArCH card facing the players. First player to guess the word correctly receive that SeArCH card.

Draw (Tie): If multiple players answer correctly at the same time; the SeArCH card will be discarded.

The name of the elements on the front of the card corresponds to their elemental symbol on the back of the card. See the colored arrows below for illustration. The elemental symbols will always follow in this order to create a word.



Determined Winner

One Player: If the player guessed more than half of the SeArCH cards correctly then they win the game!

Multiple Players: If one player obtains more SeArCH cards than the other players, they are the winner. In the event of a tie, replay the game until an eventual winner is determined.


