

# **Resolution of Censorship**

## **Michigan Senate Leadership and Michigan House of Representatives Leadership**

**We, the 11th Congressional District Republican Committee, hereby assert that the Leadership of the Michigan Senate as well as the Michigan House of Representatives have NOT upheld their sworn duty to protect and serve the Michigan people they were elected to serve.**

**Whereas**, upon being sworn into office, Michigan Senators and Representatives take an oath to uphold the United States and State Constitutions, and

**Whereas** these Constitutions state that the Legislative branch is responsible for election laws, and

**Whereas** in 2020, you allowed our Secretary of State to change our election process without your authority, and

**Whereas** you failed to hold our Secretary of State accountable for her unconstitutional actions through your failure to initiate opposition, and

**Whereas** you have consistently ignored verifiable voter fraud evidence rather than investigating said evidence, thereby leaving our election system vulnerable to foreign and domestic enemies, and

**Whereas** you approved the Electoral College delegates even though allegations of election fraud remained uninvestigated, and

**Whereas** you had the ability to subpoena judges and question them regarding their refusal to hear matters of alleged voter fraud, yet you did not do so, and

**Whereas** you used your legal counsel to push back against Republican legislators who are calling for investigations of voter fraud, and

**Whereas** you support requiring legislators to sign “non-disclosure agreements” before viewing documents and evidence, thereby preventing them from reporting their findings to their constituents,

**Therefore**, when using the Constitutions of our country and our state as our measure of your performance, it is clear that you have continually violated your oath to uphold those Constitutions.

**Be it resolved** that we, the 11<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Republican Committee submit this Resolution of Censorship.
