Our organization was founded in Bogota - Colombia in 2014 as an organization offering independent living skills training for adults with disabilities.

In 2015, founder Sandra Raffaelli established aZul for Better Living in Palm Beach County to begin operations serving the community with special needs in 2018.

To date aZul - Fashion, Art & Design, Inc. (formerly aZul For Better Living, Inc.) is a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit organization providing post secondary, alternative creative programs in fashion, art and design to adults with disabilities and their families

MISSION

To empower adults with unique abilities and their caregivers on their path to achieving artistic recognition, dignity, and financial independence.

VISION

In 5 years aZul - Fashion, Art & Desing, Inc. will expand its scope by transferring methodologies in fashion, art, and design to different organizations supporting adults with disabilities throughout the country.

GOALS 2022

- Build outreach strategies aiming to offer Sustainable Fashion Design programs in collaboration with one more organization besides Palm Beach Habilitation Center and HabCenter Boca Raton.
- Apply for the alternative training program with Vocational Rehabilitation.
- Run our signature program Follow the Thread spring season and fall season to 4 creative teams per season.
- Hire part-time administrative support for the organization

2022 A YEAR FOR LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

In 2022 aZul **impacted directly 137 adults** with unique abilities who participated in our programs in comparison with 96 serve the previous year.

The families and network surrounding the Creaitves participating in aZul programs had an indirect impact on their lives by witnessing talents, and empowerment experienced throughout the classes. The estimated indirect impact is 423 people in comparison with 285 impacted in 2021.

OUR ORGANIZATION IN PALM BEACH COUNTY

As a young organization, we have identified collaborations to be the most effective outreach strategy. Building partnerships with different organizations in Palm Beach County has brought awareness about to our mission in the community. Throughout 2021 aZul partnered with 18 organizations that were directly involved with the development of our programs, impacting the lives of those whom we serve. This strategy opened the doors for growth, supporting aZul to position itself as an organization leader in offering fashion, art, and design programs to adults with unique abilities.

AZUL PROGRAMS

All the programs offered by the organization are inclusive, groups of maximun 10 participants receive exposure to artistic and fashion training. Our methodologies aim to provide semi-personalized instruction leading the participant to master a technique to be used in their future as a vocational path to potentially start their own business venture.

Program sessions offered in house have an average fee of \$25 per session, and the "Follow the Thread" Program is offered on a scholarship basis.

In 2022 aZul offered the following programs:

FashionAble Programs

- "Follow the Thread II" Feb April (22 sessions)
- "Follow the Thread" Fall season, 5month program (40 sessions)- aZul granted 3 scholarships, valued at \$24,000.00.
- 4 FashionAble collaborative programs
 with other organizations 56 sessions

ArtAbilities

- "aZul Moves", 52 classes. 2
 performances
- 4 sewing sessions of 90 minutes.
- 6 artistic sessions of 90 minutes
