James W. Kilgore was an Ohio State Trooper for 32 years. He was an inspiration to all people through his responsibility to society, his determination to do the right thing, his ability to preserve through challenges and his sincere effort to give his best in all situations. Jim passed on these qualities to his two sons, graduates of Tri-Valley High School. He has also influenced the lives of countless others (young and old) to be stewards of the same qualities.

This scholarship is available to the Tri-Valley student that exemplifies Jim's characteristics – effort, perseverance, determination and responsibility in all walks of life. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded.

Application Criteria

Students are expected to achieve at least a 2.5 GPA with the understanding that effort, perseverance, determination and responsibility are the forces that drive the student's achievements.

Applicants must be Tri-Valley High School seniors and will be rated on cumulative grade point average, need (sources for funding post-secondary education), essay response (see essay prompt below) and teacher recommendations (2).

Completed applications must be received in the TVHS Guidance Office by 3:00 p.m. Friday, April 12, 2019. Scholarship recipients will receive their award notice at the Tri-Valley High School Senior Awards Assembly. If the student is unable to attend the ceremony, a representative may be present to accept the award. A \$1,000 check will be written to recipients from the Treasurer's Office upon receipt of their letter of acceptance and a copy of their tuition invoice. All awards are to be used for the 2019 - 2020 school year. Students must re-apply each year. Discrepancies or falsification discovered during the application process will result in the student's elimination. If discrepancies or falsifications are discovered following the award, the student must return the award to the Tri-Valley Endowment Fund.

Instructions for completion of scholarship application:

- 1. Student must complete the attached application form.
- 2. Student must attach the most current grading period's transcript from Tri-Valley High School or their current post-secondary institution.
- 3. Student must attach a letter of recommendation from two (2) certified classroom instructors with whom they have had classroom experience.
- 4. Students must complete an essay of no more than 2 one-sided pages that answers the following questions:

Describe how you have demonstrated effort (through perseverance, determination and responsibility) throughout your middle and secondary education.

How would this scholarship benefit you and how will your post-secondary education be funded (what other scholarships have you received)?

Describe your extra-curricular and community service activities and accomplishments.

What are your employment experiences?

What are your educational and professional objectives?

Add any other information you think would be helpful to the committee in making this selection.
