
Israeli-Palestinian Conflict

- Great Britain establishes the British Mandate of Palestine after World War I
- _5 Israel gains independence as the world's only Jewish state on May 14, 1948
- Great Britain allows the United Nations to decide what to do with Palestine as a result of Jewish-Arab violence
- Six-Day War (1967): Israel gains (occupies) the Sinai Peninsula, West Bank, Gaza Strip, and the Golan Heights
- United Nations votes in favor of partitioning Palestine between a Jewish and Palestinian state (The Jews were to receive 56% of the land despite being 1/3 of the population)
- Oslo Accords (1993) signed between the Israelis and the Palestinians to reach a peace agreement—FAILED!
- After the war, Israel builds settlements in the West Bank and the Gaza Strip
- Israeli withdrawal from the Gaza Strip (2005) followed by Hamas (terrorist organization) taking over the Gaza Strip (2007)
- Israel signs a peace treaty with Egypt in 1979 and returns the Sinai Peninsula
- Great Britain allows Jewish immigration to Palestine
- Arab-Israeli War (War of Independence) Ends—Israel adds territory, No Palestinian State (Jordan takes over the West Bank, Egypt take over the Gaza Strip, 700,000 Palestinian refugees)
