Our Early Years 2 to 5 years old

Our Early Years Centre with dedicated indoor and outdoor learning areas provides a home away from home for our children and their families. This environment fosters a safe, happy and exciting experience for our children, building a positive attitude to learning from their first day at school.

We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum from the UK with an inquiry-based approach to learning through play. Our highly experienced and qualified teachers work in partnership with parents to ensure that children reach their milestones in the prime areas of communication, physical development and personal, social and emotional development.

Your child will benefit from hands-on exploration, enjoying mark making, construction, role play, reading, maths, technology, movement, singing and arts and crafts to develop fine and gross motor skills. Early Years children love visiting the school library and the ICT room and enjoy weekly specialist lessons in music, swimming and physical education.

These early years at school are extremely important and go a long way in laying the foundation for a child's future passion for education.

Many of our school's student population fondly remember starting in our Early Years Centre. Two such students recently graduated with their IB Diplomas after spending 15 years at Sukhumvit 107.

Our Primary School 5 to 11 years old

At Sukhumvit 107 we incorporate the English National Curriculum and the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (IB PYP) with an Inquiry approach which focuses on the total growth of the developing child, addressing social, physical, emotional and cultural needs in addition to academic learning. We offer a comprehensive inquiry approach to learning and teaching where we also focus on student learning styles, teaching methodologies and assessment strategies.

Core subjects of English, Maths, Science and Computing objectives for each year group from the English National Curriculum are mapped into our Programme of Inquiry. Foundation subjects of History, Geography, Art, Design Technology, Music and Physical Education are also carefully mapped to ensure a broad and balanced curriculum is provided for our children

In addition, children from Year 3 learn a Modern Foreign Language (MFL) of Mandarin or French and all children will study Thai language and culture from Year 1 onwards. Students conduct most of their learning in their own classroom and visit specialist teachers in dedicated learning spaces for Music, swimming and Physical Education. We have high expectations for our students and assess their progress and attainment throughout each term. At the end of each year children will complete a standardised progress test in English and Maths. Parents are invited to teacher conferences throughout the year and written reports are also sent home. Teachers are available to see parents at any time as we have an open door policy. During the year we hold curriculum meetings, workshops for parents and assemblies which parents are welcome to attend. Our children are confident lifelong learners who are enthusiastic and excited to come to school each and every day.

Our Secondary School 11 to 18 years old

Sukhumvit 107 Secondary School follows the English National Curriculum, which offers a broad range of subjects that help develop academically-rounded students, ready to excel in examinations, and gain acceptance to world class universities of their choice worldwide.

International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)

We offer the Cambridge and Edexcel IGCSE, the world's most popular international qualifications for 14 to 16 year olds, attracting almost 500,000 entries from 144 different countries every year. Regarded as an international passport to progression and success, the two-year course comprises of core curriculum as well as subjects of the students choice. The IGCSE course culminates in external examinations at the completion of Year 11.

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)

We offer the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in the final two years of Secondary School. This is an academically challenging and comprehensive pre-university course recognised by universities worldwide. The IBDP also encompasses areas of study specifically designed to prepare students to be responsible, respectful and mature adults ready to take their place as citizens of our increasingly globalising world.

University Pathways

All our students are given close, individualised university preparation support and careers advice as they progress through Secondary School. We are very proud of their successes as they move on to some of the world's most prestigious institutions and to successful careers beyond life at Sukhumvit 107.

Music

Our music programme commences in Nursery, progressing in scale across Primary and through Secondary, offering students opportunities in 10 music performances a year.

Visual Art

Admissions

Sukhumvit 107 welcomes new applications throughout the academic year.

Step 1

To apply, visit www.standrewssukhumvit.com and submit:

- A completed and signed application
- Application Fee for each applicant
- Photocopy of parent's and child's passports and visas
- Photocopies of child's birth certificate
- 2 passport size photographs (not older than 6 months)
- Official transcript or report cards for two years prior to current grade level (translated into English)
- Educational assessment or specialist reports (where applicable)

Step 2

Once these documents have been submitted and the Application Fee has been recieved, the Admissions Office will review the application file. More information may be requested from you or the previous school. Sukhumvit 107 will then contact your family to schedule age specific assessments - which may take the form of written tests in English and Maths, a meeting with the Head of School and a half day in class. You will then be notified whether your child has met the criteria for admission

Step 3

When a place is offered, the Enrolment Fee must be paid within seven (7) days. If the Enrolment Fee is not received within 7 days, priority will be given to other applicants. The first term tuition fee is due on 1st June for the new academic year commencing in August. At other times during the school year the tuition fee must be paid in advance of entry.
