

How To Make A Minecraft Server Icon

Step one: Find an image in your Minecraft Server Icon

Step Two: Upload Image to the PNG Maker

Step Three: Edit Minecraft Server Icon

Click or faucet the eraser to open the remove background tool. This may convert your picture to a PNG and make the background transparent. If your image is already transparent and you need to remove the background color from the canvas, click the transparent icon underneath Background Colour.

You can use the modify tool to vary the looks of your server icon if you'd like a special look. Click on a filter to view a preview.

Step 4: Export and Add to Minecraft Server

Overview your icon, then choose the export image button at the highest of the PNG maker to begin processing the project.

When it's finished processing, change the file title to 'server-icon.' This file name is required to add the icon to your Minecraft server, then click Obtain to reserve it to your system. Open your server information and drag and drop the file out of your desktop or obtain folder into the basis directory of your Minecraft server. Launch and refresh your Minecraft server and your new icon should appear for all to view!
