Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



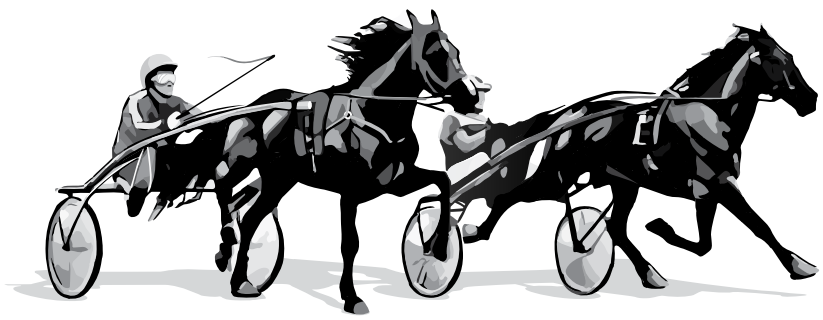
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

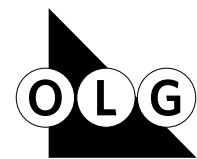
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

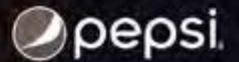

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#2 TUGGINGONCREDIT tore off cover last week in this class and then paced away from her rivals in the stretch. She won by more than two lengths in 1:52.4 and clearly enjoyed facing the softer competition in the condition claimer ranks. This mare has now been tagged twice in her life and both efforts resulted in victories here at Mohawk Park. She draws another inside post this week and should be hard to hold off. Bob McClure gets the call tonight to make her even more appealing.

#4 COLD CREEK LACEY comes into this off two rock-solid first-over victories at Grand River Raceway. She was driven like she was the best on both of those occasions and then converted as the betting favorite in each of those tries. This mare was claimed out of her latest but trainer Richard Moreau and will now return to the big track for her new connections. The classes she has been racing in match up well enough against this group, as last time it was an open \$8,500 claimer and the start before that it carried a condition that was not one for lifetime earnings. She could be dangerous.

#1 KOUNNIS disappointed as the favorite in consecutive tries in the class but had to go a difficult first-over journey in her latest. She ended up getting past the leader in the stretch but could only manage a fourth-place finish after the taxing trip. Filion opts to drive this one over the Moreau pupil above and this mare merits respect once again.

#7 HALLSGLENSMAVIS went to the lead off the gate and then got shuffled back to third by the halfway point. She stayed inside on the final turn but managed to slip to the outside at the head of the stretch to be second to the one above. This mare has been the runner-up in back-to-back efforts at this level and has hit the board in seven of nine this season.

Race 2 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 ADARE CASTLE was a \$10,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will be sent out for her lifetime debut by Mark Etsell. She has three siblings with 10 wins or more and two that have earned more than \$140,000. This filly produced two solid qualifying efforts in preparation for this, including a score on June 24th when she trotted strongly through the wire in 2:00.3. She showed final quarter speed of 27.3 in the morning prep prior to that and this daughter of Muscle Mass looks like she might be ready to strike gold at first asking.

#1 RESOLVING was a \$30,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will now make the first start of her career by trainer Rob Fellows. She lead by a wide margin in her most recent qualifier and ended up winning by more than four lengths in 2:02.4 with a final quarter of 29 seconds flat. This filly is out of the same mare that produced Lady Rainbow, who was a winner of more than \$800,000. She is not one to take lightly.

#8 PENCILS DOWN was an impressive winner in her lifetime debut on June 29th when she trotted away from her rivals in the stretch. She is one of three in the field that already have a start to their credit but the only one that has a win on her resume. This filly took a lot of support going into that contest and might be able to double up in this gold event but must overcome an outside draw.

#5 LADIES FIRST was the most expensive yearling in the field with a \$72,000 price tag at the Ontario Select sale. She will now make the first start of her career for Roger Mayotte and has two qualifiers under her belt. He then looked much better on the morning of June 19th when he was kept on a helmet for most of the journey before trotting strongly into second in the stretch to trot his own mile in 2:00.4 as the runner-up. If this son of Royalty For Life continues to make progress this evening, he might find himself in the winner's circle.

#2 LUCA HANOVER was a \$45,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will be sent out for his lifetime debut by trainer Francis Dumouchel. He is out of a mare that has produced three winners of more than \$200,000 and one millionaire in Looking Hanover. This colt comes into this with two solid morning preps and most recently was second beaten a head to Angels Express. He came home in 28.3 and went up the inside of that rival, which was likely an educational experience for this youngster. Bob McClure picks up the steer in the absence of James MacDonald.

#1 ANGELS EXPRESS was a \$23,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will be making his parimutuel debut for Tom Durand. He is a half-brother to Mister Magic that got the better of the one above in their qualifier on the morning of June 25th. This gelding pushed out to the lead from the pole position and made every call a winning one, holding on by a head at the wire in 2:02.1. He trotted his final panel in 28.4 and cannot be dismissed.

#10 MAISYS MUSCLES was a \$25,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg and will be making the first start of her career for trainer Blake MacIntosh. He battled the leader in the stretch drive and likely could not see the winner flying out wide. Sylvain Filion will be at the controls, and he is two for two aboard this gelding and one of those victories came for this outfit when he set his lifetime mark of 1:52.3. Giving this one the slight edge over his new stablemate.

#5 COOL ROCK got airborne in the final sixteenth of a mile last week to claim victory in this class, after briefly being bothered by a rival in the stretch. This 13-year-old veteran has come back into his own by wining three of his last five after going on a lengthy losing streak that spanned over two seasons. He was claimed for \$8,500 out of his latest by trainer Corey Johnson and is the other one that was claimed out of the same event by this outfit last week. Cool Rock has hit the board in each of his last seven starts but we will side with the one above tonight.

#6 NO TIME AT ALL was a pumped-up winner at Grand River Raceway two starts back in for \$8,500 and then finished fourth last time in the slop at Georgian Downs when he was only beaten a head when tagged for \$10,500. He tried to come up the cones in his latest from the two-hole and might be pointed towards the lead early tonight by Trevor Henry. He is not without a chance.

#2 MISTER GODRO was claimed out of his latest by Mitch Tierney for \$8,500. He is only a couple of starts removed from winning by six lengths here at Mohawk Park when tagged for \$8,000. This gelding is worth a look on the bottom end of the exotics at a price in the hopes that his new connections can help wake him up to a better effort.

That effort should help instill some confidence in this gelding and he now faced much easier claiming foes than the ones he went postward against in his first two starts out of the shutdown. He has been a winner in tougher spots than this and might utilize his early foot off the gate from the nine-hole. This 15-time winner wired a field of claimers when in for \$25,000 last November and we are hoping for a similar effort tonight.

#1 ALWAYS N THE MONEY finished fifth in the bottom condition in his latest when he was forwardly placed from the nine-hole and tired late after Ideal Jet went onto victory after setting taxing fractions up front. He was a winner two starts back when McNair sent him up the cones to win by a nose and he looks like he can be a factor against this group. Using underneath.

#7 STATE OF PLAY is the one you might want to land on if you are searching for a price. He was claimed out of his latest for \$15,000 by Joe Pereira and that conditioner has had success with this one in the past. This gelding had two wins for that outfit last fall and hit the board in his last six outings before being claimed away. McNair opts to stick with one above and Aaron Byron gets the call. Upset potential.

#2 ALWAYS YOUR WAY has finished third in his last three starts over the surface and only missed by a neck in each of his last two. He was claimed for \$12,000 in his latest by Scott West and now draws an inside post. Bob McClure will be at the reins, and he merits consideration.

#5 STELIOS was only beaten a neck in his latest at Georgian Downs and that was a step in the right direction after a distanced line here on June 15th. He battled a long way in his most recent effort in the off going and might be able to grab a share of it.

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the supervision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
