'V' NECK AND BUTTON-UP CARDIGANS AND BOOTEES

For Measurements and Materials see back page.

NOTES

Instructions for larger sizes are given after oblique signs. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes. We suggest that you underline the figures for the size you require before knitting.

ABBREVIATIONS

K - knit; P - purl; st(s) - stitch(es); inc - increase(ing); dec - decrease(ing); in - inch(es); cm - centimetres; mm - millimetres; tog - together; S1 - slip one stitch; pssso - pass slipped stitch over; beg - begin(ing); rep - repeat; alt - alternate; rem - remain(ing); patt - pattern; M - main shade; A - first contrast (blue); B - second contrast (pink); C - third contrast (yellow).

TENSION

12 sts and 16 rows to 2 in or 5 cm measured over patt on size 4 mm needles or the size of needles to give correct tension.

BEFORE STARTING...

Always check your tension so that your garment will knit up to the correct size. Knit a small sample and measure the sts and rows accurately. If you have less sts and rows than stated, your tension is too loose, try again on a thinner needle. If you have more sts and rows than stated, your tension is too tight, try again on a thicker needle.

'V' NECK CARDIGAN

BACK AND FRONTS

Worked in one piece to underarm.

With size 3 ¼ mm needles and M, cast on 121 / 133 / 145 / 157 sts.

1st Row: S1, * K1, P1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

2nd Row: S1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows once more.

For Girl's Cardigan Only

5th Row: (Make buttonhole), rib 3, yrn, P2tog, rib to end.

For Boy's Cardigan Only

5th Row: (Make buttonhole), rib to last 5 sts, P2tog, yrn, rib 3.

For Girl's and Boy's Cardigan

Work 2 / 4 / 6 / 8 more rows in rib.

Next Row: Rib 7 and slip these 7 sts on to a stitch holder for front band, rib to last 7 sts and slip last 7 sts on to a stitch holder for front band, turn.
— 107 / 119 / 131 / 143 sts.

Change to size 4 mm needles and joining in colours as required work in patt and stripes as follows:-

1st and 2nd Rows: With A knit.

3rd Row: With M knit.

4th Row: With M purl.

5th and 6th Rows: As 3rd and 4th rows.

Rep last 6 rows but working 1st and 2nd rows in B, then rep the same 6 rows but working 1st and 2nd rows in C, carrying colours not in use loosely up the side.

The last 18 rows form patt and stripe sequence.

Cont in patt and stripes until work measures 5 / 5 ½ / 6 ½ / 7 ½ in or 12.5 / 14 / 16.5 / 19 cm from beg, ending with a wrong side row. **

Divide Raglan Armholes

Next Row: K24 / 27 / 30 / 33, cast off next 4 sts, K51 / 57 / 63 / 69 counting st already on right hand

needle after casting off, cast off next 4 sts, K to end. Keeping patt and stripes correct work on last set of 24 / 27 / 30 / 33 sts and complete first side of front as follows:-

*** Dec one st at armhole edge on next 4 rows, then every alt row, **WHILST AT THE SAME TIME** dec one st at front edge in 2nd row, then every foll 4th row until 5 sts rem.

Now keeping front edge straight cont to dec one st at armhole edge but now in every row until 2 sts rem.

Next Row: K2tog and fasten off.

Return to rem sts and with wrong side facing rejoin appropriate colour to centre 51 / 57 / 63 / 69 sts and keeping patt and stripes correct complete back as follows:-

Dec one st at each end of next 4 rows, then every alt row until 25 / 27 / 29 / 31 sts rem.

Now dec one st at each end of every row until 19 / 21 / 23 / 25 sts rem.

Cast off.

Return to rem 24 / 27 / 30 / 33 sts and with wrong side facing rejoin appropriate colour and keeping patt and stripes correct complete second side of front to correspond with first side from ***, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

With size 3 ¼ mm needles and M, cast on 32 / 34 / 36 / 38 sts.

1st Row: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st row 7 / 9 / 11 / 13 times more.

Change to size 4 mm needles and joining in colours as required work in patt and stripes as given for main piece, inc one st at each end of 7th row and every foll 6th row until 38 / 42 / 46 / 50 sts are on needle.

Cont straight in patt and stripes until sleeve measures 5 / 5 ½ / 6 ½ / 7 in or 12.5 / 14 / 16.5 / 17.5 cm from beg, ending with same row of patt and stripe as back and fronts at underarm.

Shape Raglan Top

Keeping patt and stripes correct cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Note that more sts have been cast off than at underarm on back and fronts, this is to allow for seam.

Dec one st at each end of next 3 rows then every alt row until 6 sts rem.

Work one row straight.

Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT BAND

Slip 7 sts from holder on to a size 3 ¼ mm needle so that you are ready to begin with wrong side facing, rejoin M yarn and work in rib as follows:-

1st Row: S1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: S1, * K1, P1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2. 1st and 2nd rows form rib.

For Girl's Cardigan Only

Cont in rib making 3 more buttonholes, as before, in welt, in every 12th / 14th / 16th / 18th row, counting from previous buttonhole.

For Girl's and Boy's Cardigan

Cont in rib until band, when slightly stretched, fits up right front, across one sleeve top and back neck to left raglan edge.

Cast off in rib.

LEFT FRONT BAND

Slip 7 sts from holder on to a size 3 ¼ mm needle so that you are ready to begin with right side facing,

rejoin M yarn and work in rib as follows:-

1st Row: S1, * K1, P1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

2nd Row: S1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

1st and 2nd rows form rib.

For Boy's Cardigan Only

Cont in rib making 3 more buttonholes, as before, in welt, in every 12th / 14th / 16th / 18th row, counting from previous buttonhole.

For Boy's and Girl's Cardigan

Cont in rib until band, when slightly stretched, fits up left front and across one sleeve top.

Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Read pressing instructions on ball band and press pieces carefully on wrong side, avoiding rib. With a fine backstitch sew sleeve seams, then sew sleeves into armholes. Placing top buttonhole just below first shaping at front edge, sew front bands neatly in position and join together at back left raglan seam. Sew on buttons. Press seams.

BUTTON-UP CARDIGAN

BACK AND FRONTS

Work exactly as given for 'V' Neck Cardigan to **.

Divide Raglan Armholes

Next Row: K24 / 27 / 30 / 33, cast off next 4 sts, K51 / 57 / 63 / 69 counting st already on right hand needle after casting off, cast off next 4 sts, K to end. Keeping patt and stripes correct work on last set of 24 / 27 / 30 / 33 sts and complete first side of front as follows:-

Dec one st at armhole edge on next 4 rows, then every alt row until 14 / 15 / 17 / 18 sts rem.

Work one row straight.

Shape Neck

1st Row: Work 2tog, work to last 3 / 4 / 4 / 5 sts and slip these last 3 / 4 / 4 / 5 sts on to a stitch holder for neckband, turn.

**** Now cont to dec one st at armhole edge in every alt row, **WHILST AT THE SAME TIME** dec one st at neck edge in 1st and 2nd rows then every alt row until 5 sts rem.

Now keeping neck edge straight cont to dec one st at armhole edge but now in every row until 2 sts rem.

Next Row: K2tog and fasten off.

Return to rem sts and with wrong side facing rejoin appropriate colour to centre 51 / 57 / 63 / 69 sts and keeping patt and stripes correct complete back as follows:-

Dec one st at each end of next 4 rows, then every alt row until 25 / 27 / 29 / 31 sts rem.

Now dec one st at each end of every row until

19 / 21 / 23 / 25 sts rem.

Slip sts on to a stitch holder.

Return to rem 24 / 27 / 30 / 33 sts and with wrong side facing rejoin appropriate colour at inside edge and keeping patt and stripes correct complete second side of front as follows:-

Dec one st at armhole edge in next 4 rows then every alt row until 14 / 15 / 17 / 18 sts rem.

Work one row straight. Break off yarn.

Shape Neck

1st Row: Slip first 3 / 4 / 4 / 5 sts on to a stitch holder for neckband, rejoin appropriate colour and work to last 2 sts, work 2tog.

Complete neck to correspond with first side of neck from ****, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Work exactly as given for sleeves of 'V' Neck Cardigan but slip rem 6 sts on to a stitch holder instead of casting off.

RIGHT FRONT BAND FOR GIRL

Slip 7 sts from holder on to a size 3¼ mm needle so that you are ready to begin with wrong side facing rejoin M yarn and work in rib as follows:-

1st Row: S1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: S1, * K1, P1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2. 1st and 2nd rows form rib.

Cont in rib making 4 more buttonholes, as before, in welt, in every 10th / 12th / 14th / 16th row, counting from previous buttonhole, then work 8 / 10 / 12 / 14 rows in rib after last buttonhole.

Slip sts on to a stitch holder.

LEFT FRONT BAND FOR GIRL

Slip 7 sts from holder on to a size 3¼ mm needle so that you are ready to begin with right side facing, rejoin M yarn and work in rib as follows:-

1st Row: S1, * K1, P1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

2nd Row: S1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

1st and 2nd rows form rib.

Cont in rib until band corresponds with right front band, ending at inside edge.

Slip sts on to a stitch holder.

LEFT FRONT BAND FOR BOY

Work as given for left front band for girl making 4 more buttonholes, as before, in welt, in every 10th / 12th / 14th / 16th row, counting from previous buttonhole, then work 7 / 9 / 11 / 13 rows in rib after last buttonhole.

Slip sts on to a stitch holder.

RIGHT FRONT BAND FOR BOY

Work as given for right front band for girl omitting buttonholes and working until band corresponds with left front band, ending at inside edge.

Slip sts on to a stitch holder.

NECKBAND

Slip 7 sts from holder on right front band on to a size 3¼ mm needle so that you are ready to begin with right side facing.

Rejoin M yarn and K3 / 4 / 4 / 5 sts from holder at right front neck; pick up and K6 / 7 / 8 / 9 sts from shaped edge of neck; K6 sts from one sleeve top; K19 / 21 / 23 / 25 sts from back neck; K6 sts from other sleeve top; pick up and K6 / 7 / 8 / 9 sts from shaped edge of left front neck and K3 / 4 / 4 / 5 sts from holder; rib 7 sts from holder at left front band. — 63 / 69 / 73 / 79 sts.

Work 5 rows in rib, as given for right front band for girl, making 6th buttonhole, as before, in 2nd row. Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Read pressing instructions on ball band and press pieces carefully on wrong side, avoiding rib. With a fine backstitch sew sleeve seams, then sew sleeves into armholes. Sew front bands neatly in position. Sew on buttons. Press seams.

BOOTEES

With size 3¼ mm needles and M, cast on 26 / 28 / 30 / 32 sts.

1st Row: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st row once more.
Change to size 4 mm needles and joining in colours as required work in patt and stripes as follows:-

1st and 2nd Rows: With A knit.

3rd Row: With M knit.

4th Row: With M purl.

Rep last 4 rows but working 1st and 2nd rows in B, then rep the same 4 rows but working 1st and 2nd rows in C.

The last 12 rows form patt and stripe sequence.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows once more.

Divide Foot

1st Row: Work 17 / 18 / 19 / 20, turn.

2nd Row: P8, turn.

Keeping patt and stripes correct work 10 rows straight on these 8 sts. Break off all colours.

With right side facing rejoin M yarn where sts were divided and pick up and K6 sts from side of instep; K8 sts from needle; pick up and K6 sts from other side of instep and K to end across rem sts.

— 38 / 40 / 42 / 44 sts.

Knit one row.

Shape shoe effect as follows:-

1st Row: K14 / 15 / 16 / 17, inc in next st, K7, inc in next st, K to end.

2nd Row: K15 / 16 / 17 / 18, inc in next st, K7, inc in next st, K to end.

3rd Row: K16 / 17 / 18 / 19, inc in next st, K7, inc in next st, K to end.

4th Row: K17 / 18 / 19 / 20, inc in next st, K7, inc in

next st, K to end. — 46 / 48 / 50 / 52 sts.

Work 4 / 4 / 3 / 3 rows straight.

For 3rd and 4th Sizes Only

Next Row: K / 24 / 25, inc in next st, K to end. — / 51 / 53 sts.

For All Sizes

Shape Sole

1st Row: K26 / 27 / 29 / 30, S1, K1, pssso, turn.

2nd Row: S1, K6 / 6 / 7 / 7, K2tog, turn.

3rd Row: S1, K6 / 6 / 7 / 7, S1, K1, pssso, turn.

4th Row: S1, K6 / 6 / 7 / 7, K2tog, turn.

Rep 3rd and 4th rows until 4 / 4 / 5 / 5 sts rem each side of the centre 8 / 8 / 9 / 9 sts.

Next Row: K to end of needle.

Cast off knitways.

Strap

With size 4 mm needles and M, cast on 15 / 15 / 17 / 17 sts.

Knit one row.

Cast of knitways.

TO MAKE UP

With a fine backstitch sew back seam to cast off edge. Placing seam to centre of sole sew seam across heel. Sew one end of strap in position and sew a button on opposite end sewing strap in position at the same time. Reverse strap and button fastening on second Bootee. Read pressing instructions on ball band and press carefully on wrong side.

MATERIALS

BABY D.K.

EACH CARDIGAN Main shade

3 4 4 5 20g balls

1st, 2nd & 3rd colour

1 1 1 1 20g ball

Bootees Main shade

1 1 1 1 20g ball

1 pair knitting needles each size 3¼ mm (No 10) and 4 mm (No 8) or the size of needles to give correct tension.

4 buttons for 'V' Neck Cardigan. 6 buttons for Button-Up Cardigan. 2 buttons for Bootees. Stitch holders.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.
