## To prevent gun violence, stop poisoning children with aluminum and fluorine

In the year 2012, Adam Lanza was accused of shooting people at Sandy Hook Elementary School. It was reported that Mr. Lanza, who is now deceased, had autism.

In February of this year the *Sun Sentinel* newspaper reported that the suspect in the shootings at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School has autism.

The *Sun Sentinel's* report caused me to start searching the Internet for information about autism. An article published in the scientific journal *Aggression and Violent Behavior* included the finding that "...a significant proportion of mass or serial killers may have had neurodevelopmental disorders such as autism spectrum disorder or head injury".

On February 7, 2018 a Commission of Inquiry of the Chamber of Deputies of the Parliament of Italy approved an "Inquiry Report".

The Commission's report cites a scientific study about the levels of aluminum in the brains of deceased people who had been diagnosed as autistic during their lifetimes. The authors of the study wrote, "We have made the first measurements of aluminium in brain tissue in ASD [autism spectrum disorder] and we have shown that the brain aluminium content is extraordinarily high".

The report of the Commission of Inquiry also cites an article published in the *Journal of Toxicology* in 2014. The article is titled "Aluminum-Induced Entropy in Biological Systems: Implications for Neurological Disease". The article reads, in part, "Aluminium forms toxic complexes with other elements, such as fluorine, and interacts negatively with mercury, lead and glyphosate. Aluminum has a negative impact on the central nervous system in all species that have been studied, including humans". The authors of the article concluded that the toxicity of aluminum warrants "considerations at a policy level to limit human exposure to aluminum and its compounds".

In 1998, a group of scientists found "that giving rats water containing fluoride at 1 ppm [**p**art **p**er **m**illion] led to kidney damage, brain damage, and a greater uptake of aluminum into the brain, and increased the formation of beta amyloid deposits often characteristic of Alzheimer's disease. The aluminum level in the brains of the fluoride-treated group was double that of the controls".
