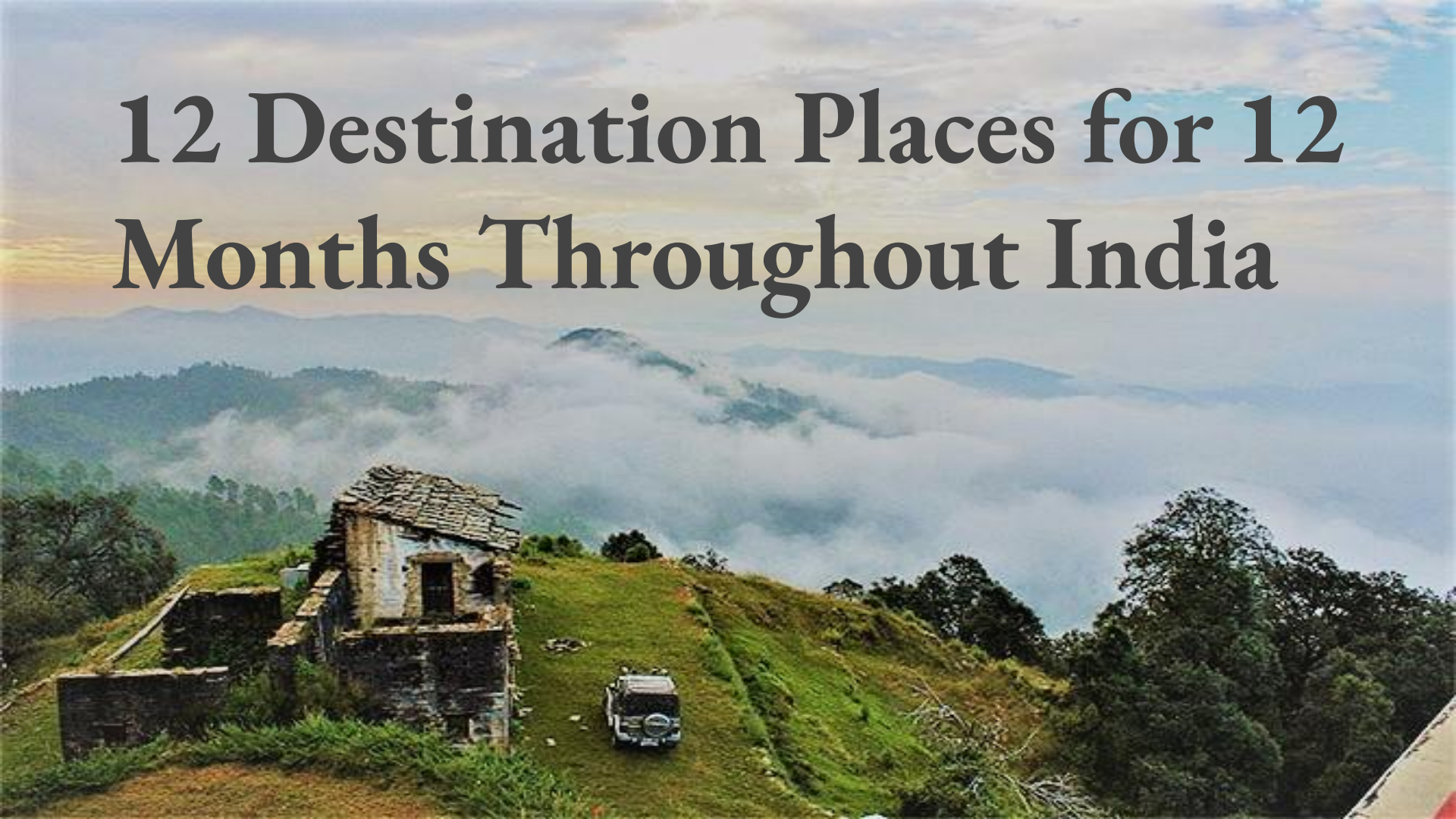


# 12 Destination Places for 12 Months Throughout India



For people who love to travel, there is not a single place in the world that is truly far away.

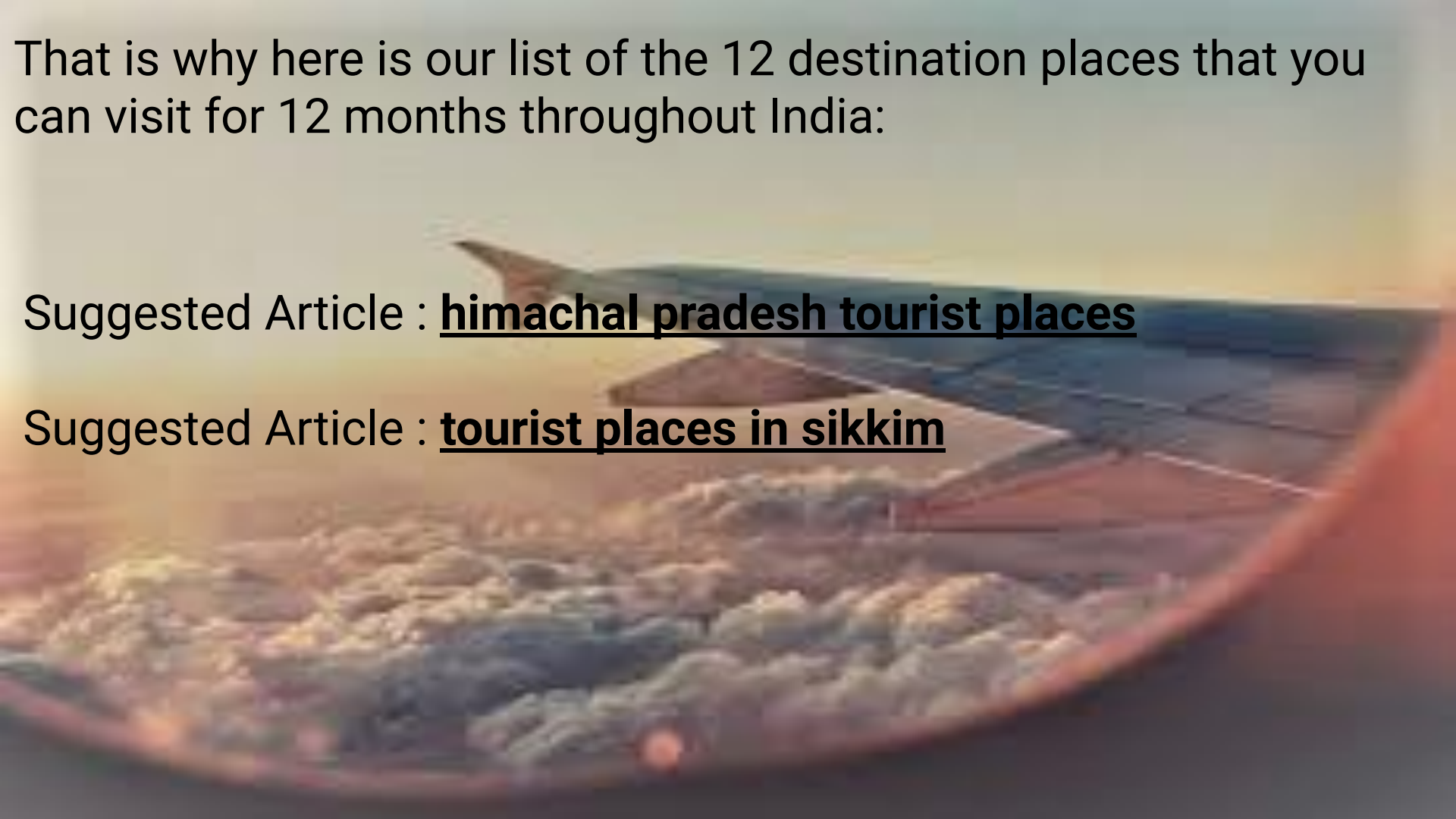


For these people, traveling is not just a habit, but it's a passion worth holding on to.

**March is the best time to visit the Andaman and Nicobar islands with a pleasant temperature of around 20 degrees.**

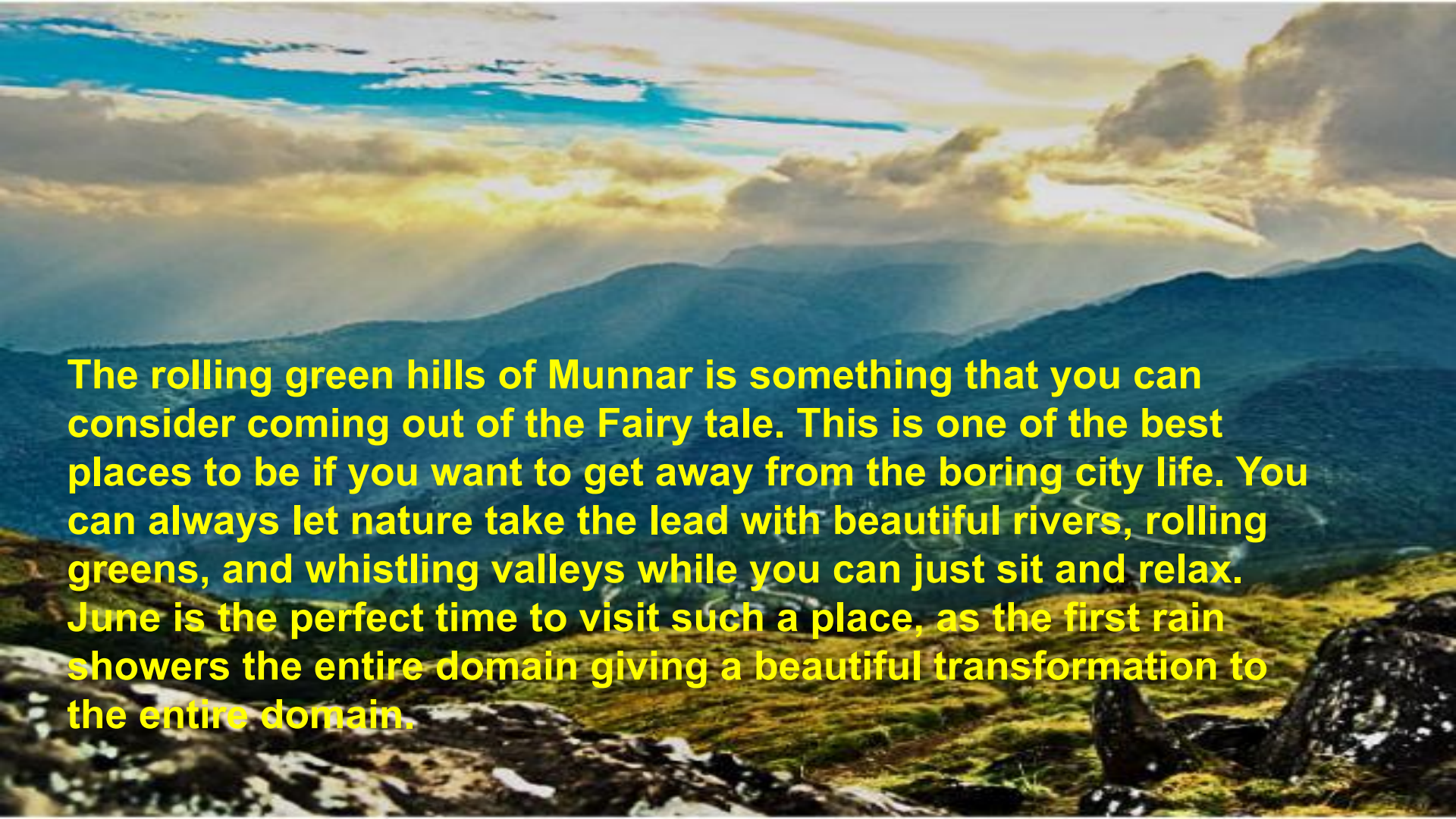
