



Royal Decree 2020/120

of the 18th of May, by which the Imperial embassy established in the capital of the Union of Sovereign States and Republics on the 18th of April is hereby extinguished.

BE IT ENACTED by Her Royal Majesty, Queen Eleanor IV of the Eothasi Realm, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords and Ladies of this present Cabinet assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Royal Decree 2020/120 of the 18th of May, by which the Imperial embassy established in the capital of the Union of Sovereign States and Republics on the 18th of April is hereby extinguished and Honourable Ambassador Soline Herzog, as well as all members of the delegation attached to this mission, are to return to the Imperial Eothasi Commonwealth effective immediately.

As per Ministerial Direction 1952/1147 of the 21st of November, under which the Diplomatic Cooperation Initiative was officially formed as a branch of the Imperial Foreign Office, the specification was made detailing the necessity of adherence to the Principle of Reciprocity. Failure to comply with this part was grounds for removal of any and all permanent Imperial delegators from foreign territories within thirty days of the signing of the agreement to establish said permanent presence. Given that this has not been the case in this particular instance, the Imperial Foreign Office hereby:

Article I.

1. Extinguishes the Imperial embassy in the Union of Sovereign States and Republics;
2. Recalls to the Imperial Eothasi Commonwealth Honourable Ambassador Soline Herzog;
3. Recalls to the Imperial Eothasi Commonwealth all additional delegation members, consisting of:
 - a. [2] Legal Attaché, [3] Economic & Trade Attaché, [2] Cultural Attaché, [1] Defense Attaché, [1] Charge d'Affaire;
 - b. [10] Ambassadorial Guard;
 - c. [5] Personal Secretaries of Ambassador & Diplomatic Staff, [5] Councillor's Staff, [1] Official Embassy Press Spokesperson, [2] Diplomatic Cooperation Initiative Liaison Officers, [4] Medical Staff, [4] Chef & Staff, [10] Other;



Article II.

1. Terminates any and all negotiation processes established between the Union of Sovereign States and Republics and the Imperial Eothasi Commonwealth at this time.

Article III.

1. The Cabinet of Ministries provides the reassurance that, should the Union of Sovereign States and Republics decide to retake diplomatic cooperation with the Imperial Eothasi Commonwealth, they may do so at their own discretion.
2. Please note that any and all such applications will not receive any additional preference due to the pre-existing embassy of the Imperial Eothasi Commonwealth in the capital city of Moscow, and will be subject to the rules and regulations as established by the Diplomatic Cooperation Initiative wherever pertinent.
3. The Imperial Foreign Office encourages the corresponding members of the Soviet government to examine the programme provided by the [Diplomatic Cooperation Initiative](#) on the main platform for such negotiations.
