These waters have been extensively stocked with a selection of coarse fish. The larger lake contains a variety of carp species and silver fish including barbel. The smaller lake is a mixed

fishery. The fishery is open all year during daylight hours for the enjoyment of club members. Two toilets are installed on the site.

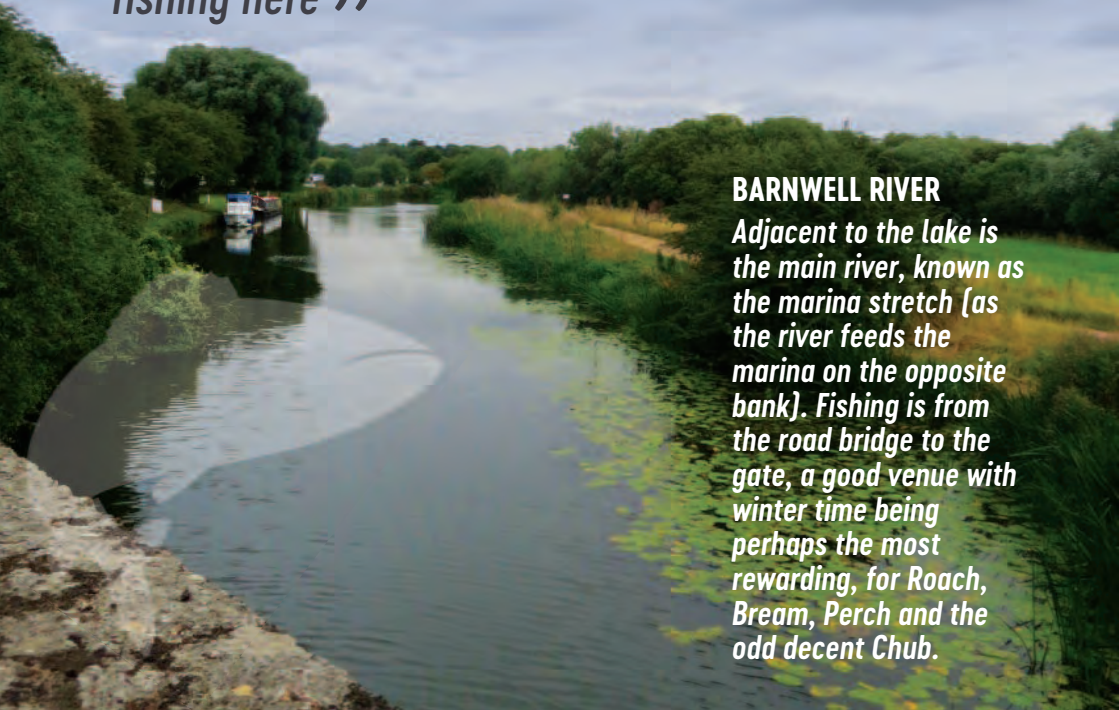

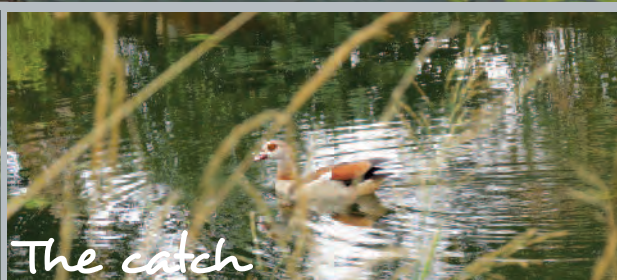

Classic Nene Fishery for Roach, Perch, Bream & Chub.

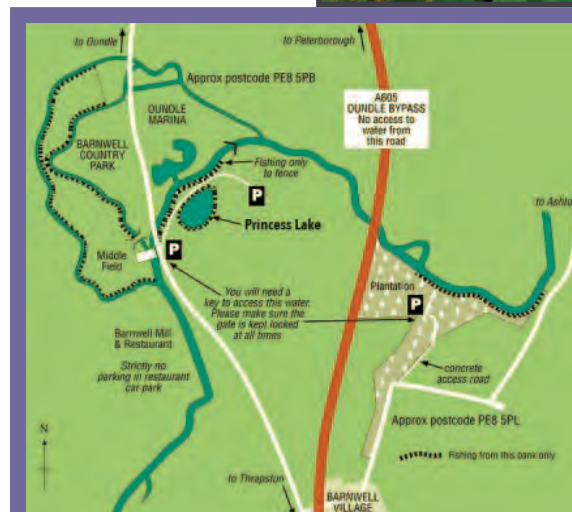

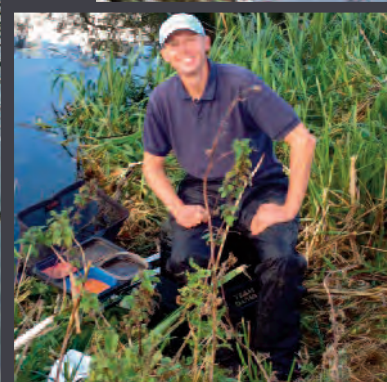

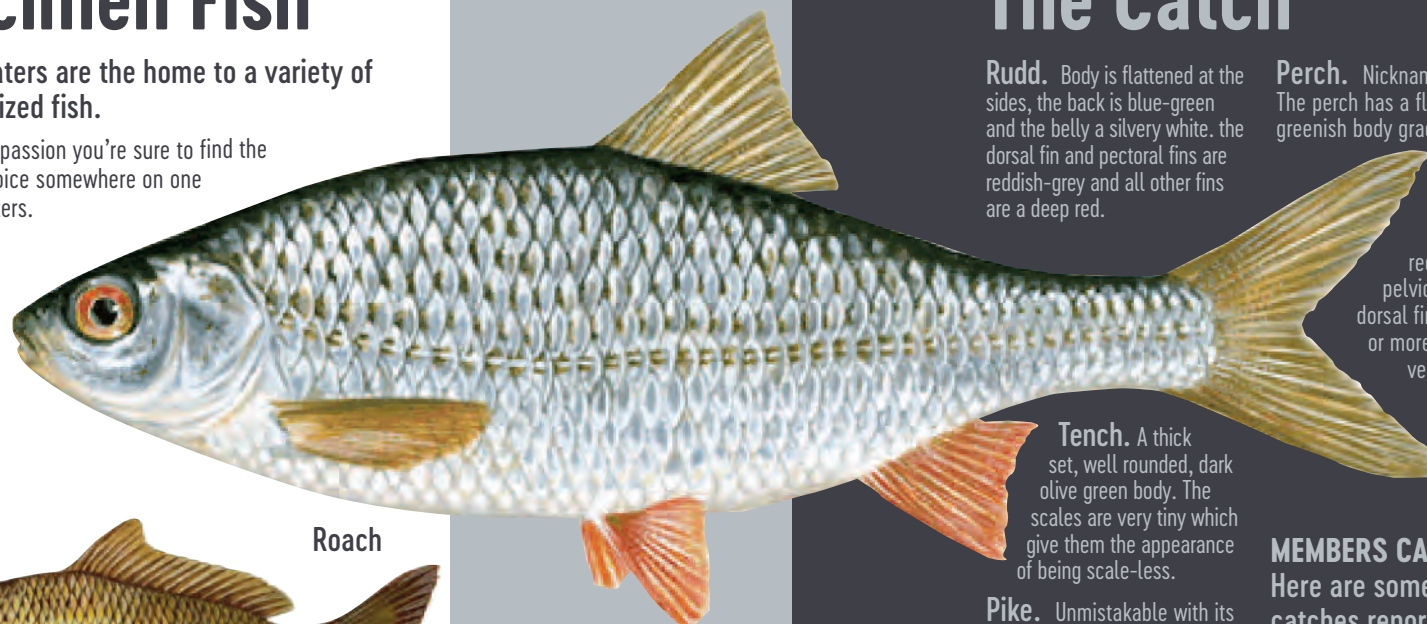

WDNAC Specimen Fish

Our Club waters are the home to a variety of Specimen sized fish.

Whatever your passion you're sure to find the fish of your choice somewhere on one of our club waters.

Roach. A moderately deep bodied fish with silvery white sides, dark brown or grey back with a bluish or greenish tint, red/orange eyes, large silvery scales and red lower fins, hence the nickname, 'Redfin'.

Carp. There are different variants of carp:- Common carp, Mirror carp, Leather carp, Grass carp, Ghost carp and Koi carp.

Chub. A thick set fish with a large blunt head. It has a long and cylindrical body with large greenish/brown scales that have a slight black edging across the back.

Bream. Adults are deep bodied and bronze in colour with darker, sometimes black fins. Has a prominent covering of protective slime.

WDNAC The Catch

Rudd. Body is flattened at the sides, the back is blue-green and the belly a silvery white. the dorsal fin and pectoral fins are reddish-grey and all other fins are a deep red.

Perch. Nickname 'Stripey'. The perch has a flat-sided greenish body graduating down to a white belly. It has bright red/orange pelvic fins, two dorsal fins with five or more broad black vertical stripes down the sides.

Tench. A thick set, well rounded, dark olive green body. The scales are very tiny which give them the appearance of being scale-less.

Pike. Unmistakable with its distinguished striped or spotted pattern body, large broad head, flattened snout and huge mouth full of sharp, backward facing teeth.

Barbel. Light to greenish brown with yellowish sides. The fins are darker except for the pectoral, pelvic and anal fins which are yellowish orange.

Crucian Carp. Amongst the smallest members of the family which includes other fish such as the Common Carp. The Crucian is different in that it doesn't have barbules and rarely reaches a weight above 3.3 lb.

The first sunday of each month the club organise a match fishing event. This can be held on club waters or away.

MATCH SECRETARY - IVOR STOKES

I have been Match Secretary for more years than I care to remember. A member since the 70's – I have fished for Wellingborough in nationals and other more local team events with varying degrees of success.

My aim as Match Secretary is to help promote the club and get as many club members as possible to fish our matches. We try to fish venues to suit all anglers from rivers to lakes, carp venues, canals and fenland waters. We also like to fish our own waters as much as possible to save on peg fees. On average, out of our ten club matches, three will be on away venues. The cost to enter club matches is £10.00; £8.00 is for pools with a £1.00 entry fee and £1.00 for golden peg.

The beauty of golden peg is it soon accumulates so you could be fishing a 15 peg club match that could win you £140.

I am always open to suggestions for away venues and ways to improve our matches so please call me on Tel: 01933-389309.

We are also looking for new members to fish our team matches i.e. 1st Division National, George Barker Winter League, George Shepherd, teams of 6, and Northants County Championship, teams of 8, which this year was fished on our stretch of the Grand Union Canal and contested by 96 anglers.

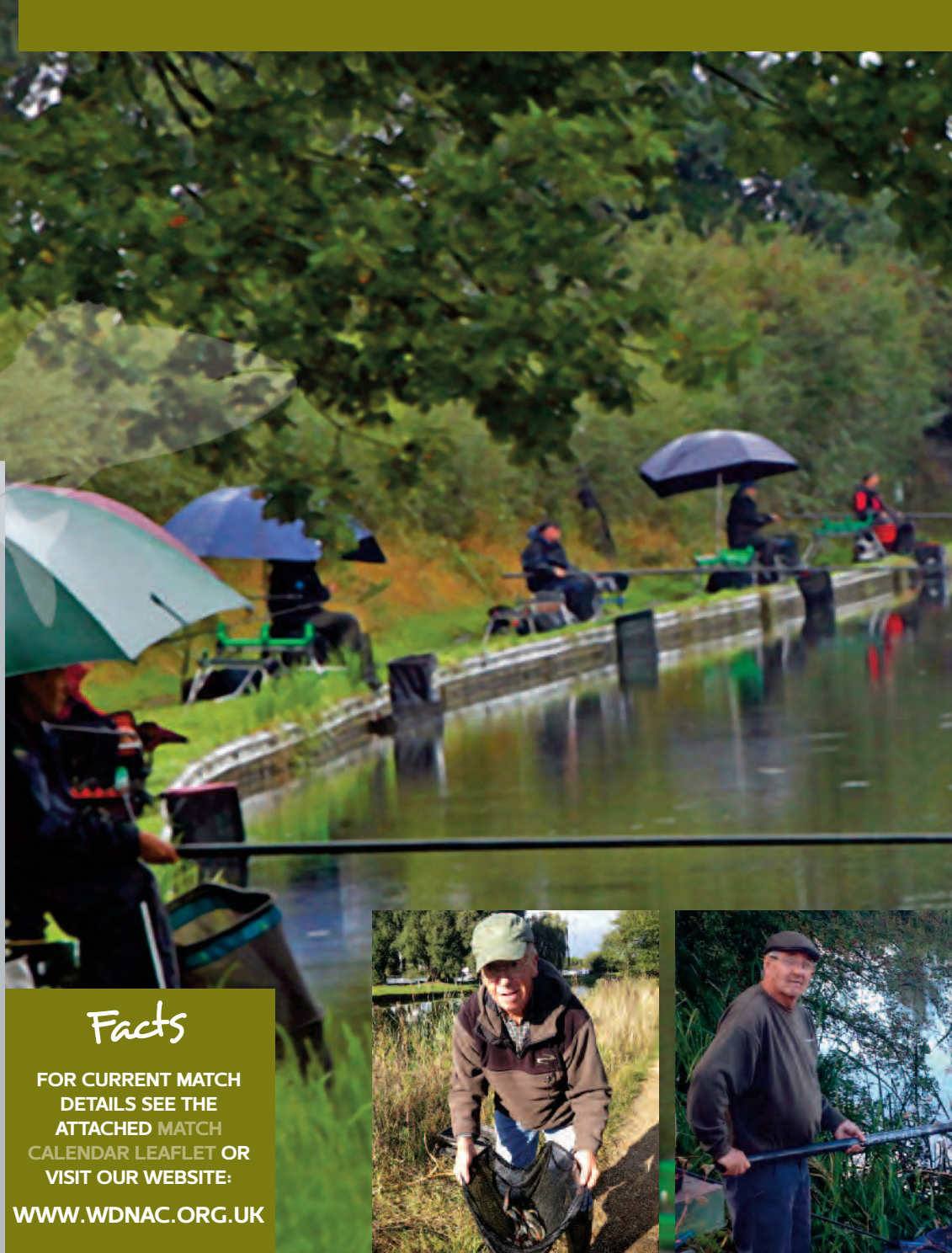

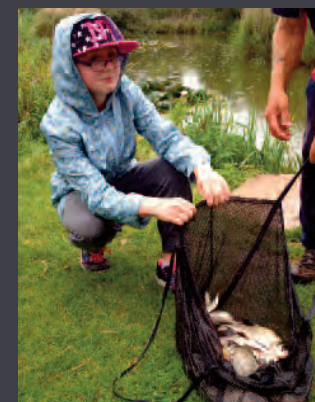
