

Types of R2 Scholarship Projects

For your R2 Scholarship Project, you must choose one of three options:

- 1. A Quality Improvement Project: either continue your R1 project or do a new project. For more information, check out page 11 of our QI Handbook: <u>https://is.gd/trY5T5</u>
- A Research Project: complete a research project from design, data collection, analysis, and reporting of findings. For more information, check out our Research Handbook: <u>https://is.gd/xLUm1G</u>
- 3. A Systematic Review "Plus" Project: complete a structured literature review on a topic of your choosing, then create a product based on your findings. The product is based on your literature review findings and can be anything that communicates these findings. Examples of the Plus component include clinical cards, lunch n' learn workshops, podcasts, virtual patients, etc. just express your ideas for this part of your project in your LOI and proposal. The Plus component is neither your final report nor your Resident Scholarship Day presentation, it is something *in addition* to these requirements.
