Paint America Orange Guidelines to Success Raising Money & Awareness



Dear Paint America Orange Participant,

Thank you for your interest in hosting a fundraising event for Brooke USA! We are grateful for all of the individuals and groups who support our mission of alleviating the suffering of working horses, donkeys and mules, and the people they serve in the developing world. Without your assistance, our work could not be possible. This packet contains information about Brooke USA, including suggestions to help you organize and plan your event. Please keep in mind that we are providing suggestions, not requirements, and we hope that you will plan your event to best suit your needs as well as any donors that you plan to engage. A few important things to consider when planning your fundraising event:

<u>Location</u>: Permitting and licensing can quickly become a hurdle of many event hosts. Be sure to consider locations that have the least restrictive permitting and insurance requirements. For example, many venues will already have a liquor license (restaurants, bars, banquet halls, etc.). If you are hoping to serve alcohol at your event, please be sure to find a location that meets the requirements of your local municipality.

<u>Sponsors</u>: Working to obtain business and corporate sponsors for your event will payoff in the initial planning phases. Securing sponsors early on will allow you to have some discretionary money to spend as needed for items such as venue fees, catering and entertainment. Be sure to recognize your sponsors during the event with signage, logos and announcements. They could also be invited to attend the event for free.

<u>Donations</u>: Most businesses and individuals will be more than willing to donate goods or services for your event. Be sure to solicit in-kind donations for food, beverages, decorations, entertainment, photographers, printing, etc. In-kind donors can also supply goods and services for silent auctions, raffles and goodie bags. Anyone who files yearly taxes can write-off their in-kind donations, so be sure to properly document all in-kind donations, just as you document financial contributions.

<u>Other</u>: Some states, counties and/or municipalities have strict guidelines on raffles and other games of change. Be sure to check with your local City Hall first.

Tips for a Successful Fundraiser

Getting Started

- Come up with an idea that is fun and inspiring for you and your friends. Every idea is a good one when you're volunteering your time and skills to give back to Brooke USA.
- Make the first donation to prove to everyone that you believe in what you are doing and the mission of Brooke USA.

Promoting Your Event

- Send a personalized email and/or letter to friends, family and colleagues; just ask everyone you know and wherever you go. Then, follow-up, follow-up and follow-up. Tell them why Brooke USA is important to you.
- Inquire if your company matches funds. Ask your employer if you can include your Brooke USA fundraiser in the company's newsletter.
- Use social media Facebook, Twitter, Instagram to get the word out about your Brooke USA fundraiser. Set-up a schedule for posting and remember to include your personal milestones and stories. You can always thank people in your social network and then tag them in a post so that everyone sees what you are doing and what your friends have done for you.
- Create and customize a fundraising page on Facebook or Crowdrise. This will help promote your event while raising funds right then and there. Schedule future posts, and include your milestones and progress toward your goal. Thank everyone for donating toward your Brooke USA fundraiser, give updates and add photos.

Using Crowdrise

- Go to Crowdrise.com and start fundraising immediately! Create your personal fundraising campaign for Brooke USA.
- Funds are disbursed to Brooke USA on a monthly basis, directly from Crowdrise. Just let a team member at Brooke USA know what you are doing.
- Here are some important considerations when creating your personal fundraising campaign:
 - 1. Find Brooke USA on the charity list.
 - 2. Create a "WOW" title for your fundraiser.
 - 3. Add a fundraising goal (start small as you can always up-it).
 - 4. Tell everyone why you support Brooke USA.
 - 5. Add personal stories and anecdotes as well as photos.
 - 6. Share with friends via email and social media; you can do this right from your fundraising page.
 - 7. Be sure to follow-up with friends and thanks those who have supported you.

Partnering with Others

- Establish key partnerships with local businesses and organizations to help finance your event via a sponsorship or by donating items to your silent auction or offering in-kind donations to help produce the event (i.e., beverages, printing, photography, etc.).
- What can you offer potential sponsors in return for their donation? Be creative. The more your offer, the more likely they are to join you; just look at some ideas on your Sample Sponsorship Package.

Thanking Everyone

• Most people are doing this for you and want to be recognized by you. Be sure to thank each person for their support and for supporting your efforts on behalf of Brooke USA.

Remember, Brooke USA staff is just a phone call or email away. Any member of the team can answer questions, provide advice and share their own experiences.

Third-Party Event Ideas

- Cycling/Bike-a-thon You can organize a bike ride for Brooke USA.
- Putting for Brooke USA You can partner with a golf course to host a fun tournament.

- Garage Sale This is the perfect way to get rid of all that stuff that you no longer need and donate the proceeds to Brooke USA. You can also you use Ebay
- **Bar Night** Talk to your local bar manager and hold an event where a portion of the drinks are donated to Brooke USA. Sometimes, during happy hour, the bar may donate snacks.

All donations made to Brooke USA are used toward our mission. Unfortunately, once funds are received in our office, we cannot reimburse event expenses.

Can Brooke USA provide volunteers for my event?

Just email us a short description of your event, including date, time, location and number of people expected to be in attendance. Due to limited resources and high demand, we may not be able to honor all requests. Please submit requests 8 hours before the event date. Be sure to let us know how many volunteers you need and we will attempt to partner you with other local supporters.

Can Brooke USA help promote my event/fundraiser? We can certainly add information on your fundraiser on Facebook and Instagram. We also encourage you to use #BrookeUSA #PaintAmericaOrange #WorkingEquines #MakeChange on social media to publicize your event.
