But, on a general note, a good and perfect act is built on good vision (foresight). Even the ability to interpret the role of a blind man in a play or movie needs vision (sight).

Therefore, vision by which by implication is good sight, is essential and needful for successful acting.

On the other hand, I will also deal with vision in the context of envisaging the future, which is the ability to plan for the future. But first, let's look at acting.

#### **ACTING**

Acting could be referred to as the art of performing fictional roles in plays, drama and films. It could also be seen as an activity in which a story is being told by means of script writing and the story is being interpreted into play by actors, by adopting characters in the story.

- Acting can be a talent or skill.

# CLASSES OF ACTING

There are diverse classes of acting; but for this study we will be looking at just a few and they are;

- ✓ SCENE STUDY AND TECHNIQUE CLASS:

  This presupposes the study scenes in between lines and the rightful application of technique for each scene breakdown
- ✓ AUDITIONING CLASS: This class teaches how to breakdown scripts (Script Analysis) especially during auditions; what to do during an audition and how to get approval from the casting panel.
- ✓ ON-CAMERA (SCREEN) CLASS: This class emphasizes on the ability and how to control your voice on set, where to stand, where to go, and other on-camera acting techniques.
- ✓ IMPROVISATION CLASS: This class has to do with the ability to think fast especially

  - ✓ VOCAL CLASS: This class has to do with
    the proper usage of voice, breath control
    and other vocal technique in acting.
  - ✓ VOICE-OVER CLASS: Has to do with the proper usage and identification of voicing to match the character on stage or on set.

#### VISION:

now. It is the ability to sight something imaginary. A vision is a key in maximizing success in life and fulfilling destiny.

Success does not happen by chance, it is predetermined; therefore the future must be properly envisioned.

Visions may originate from talents or skills and therefore is actualized as a destiny.

Vision can be "short termed or long termed"

Vision requires internal stability:— Stability enables you stand firm and focused on your vision (especially as a director), suggestions and ideas will come from left and right, but internal stability stays you focused on your vision.

Your passion reveals your vision, and "your vision is a **MOTIVATOR** and a **BOOSTER** to you PASSION. Your vision is also a light, it brightens the path of your Passion" – Oluchi Omai.

Your sense of value also reflects your vision.

Acting needs vision, they are two inseparable entities.
