Place Collection items at the curb by **7:30 a.m.** on your collection day

Collection Zones Map

Set out garbage cans or bags **every second week**, according to the schedule for your Zone (see cover).

Every second week

Two garbage cans/bags at the curb by **7:30 a.m.** on your collection day. (Check garbage collection week for your zone on front).

Weekly:

Green Can at the curb by **7:30 a.m.** on your collection day; not before 8 p.m. the night before.

Put out as many Green Cans as you need.

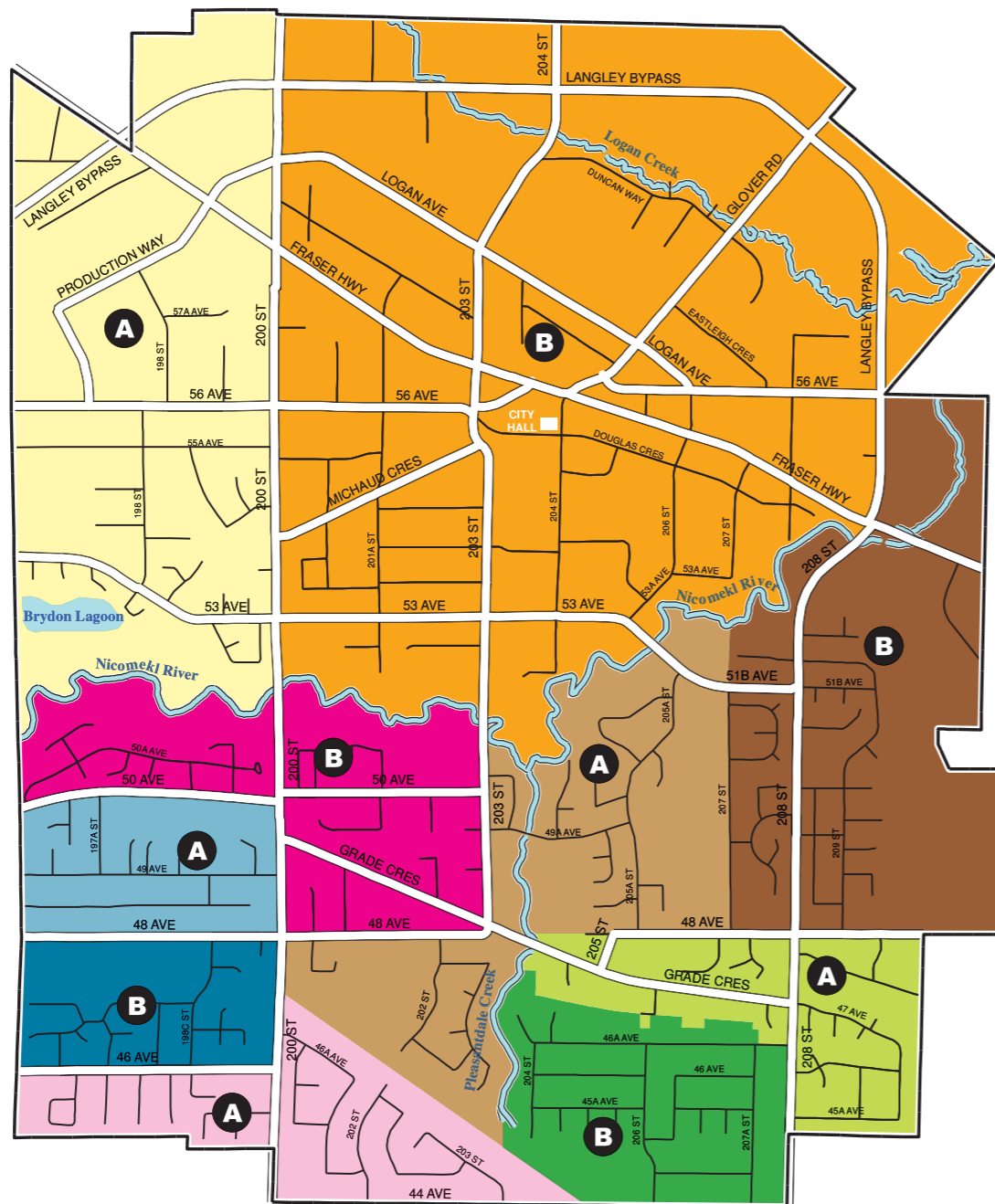
On B weeks:

WHAT CAN YOU PUT INTO YOUR GREEN CAN?

Kitchen scraps including:
fruits & vegetables
meat, poultry, fish
bones
cheese
bread & grains

Yard waste including:
fresh green garden
waste
twigs, small branches
and prunings
wood chips, shavings
leaves, weeds, plants,
flowers
grass & clippings
straw, pumpkins

Kitchen Soiled Paper including:
shredded paper
cardboard egg cartons
coffee filters
tea bags
paper towels, napkins

NO PLASTIC BAGS!
Not even biodegradable or compostable plastic bags!
The bags don't break down fast enough during the composting process. Instead line your Green Can with newspaper or cardboard.

DO NOT INCLUDE:
rocks, soil, sod, stumps
animal waste
diapers
painted/treated wood
branches over 3" in
diameter

WHAT TO DO ABOUT RODENTS GETTING IN THE GREEN CAN?

Just as you would need to take precautions with your regular garbage, ensure your Green Can has a tight fitting lid. If possible, store your Green Can in a secure place, e.g. in your garage or shed. Wait until morning to place your Green Can at the curb (by 7:30 am).

THE GREEN CAN AND FREEZING TEMPERATURES

During the colder months, food scraps may freeze to the bottom of your can. As such, you may wish to line the bottom of your Green Can with cardboard or newspaper, and layer yard trimmings with food scraps or newspapers.

AVOID THE MESS:

- Kitchen catchers or plastic containers with a lid are handy to temporarily store your food scraps in before emptying into the curbside Green Can
- Wrap food scraps in newspaper and tie closed with yarn or string
- Line the bottom of your Green Can with newspaper
- Paper bags designed for food waste available for purchase at local retailer; **No plastic bags permitted**
- Place food scraps in your freezer (particularly cooked food); place frozen scraps in the Green Can on collection day



REMEMBER:
Container must display a Green Can sticker.
Sticker must face street.
Cans do not have to be a green colour.



Extra Green Can or yard waste stickers available free of charge at City Hall and Timms Community Centre.

Acceptable

Size: 77 L or 80 L



- Made of rigid plastic
- Strong enough to withstand collection activity
- Watertight and removable lid (lid must not be attached to can)
- Two durable handles for safe emptying
- 45L Green Cart Dimensions: 12" x 11" x 27"
- 2-ply water resistant compostable Kraft paper yard waste bags

Maximum Weight when filled: 44 lbs/ 20kg.

GREEN WASTE/ YARD TRIMMING PROGRAM

The City provides weekly collection of green yard waste year round.

Acceptable green waste materials:

- leaves
- grass
- clippings
- branches
- kitchen food scraps
- newspaper and/or brown paper bags to hold green waste

GREEN WASTE TIPS

- Use designated Green Can containers (see acceptable sizes) marked with a Green Can sticker (turn sticker to face the street; additional stickers available at City Hall)
- Tie branches securely in bundles to a maximum of 1m X 60cm, 20kg
- Leaves can be put in double-ply, water resistant, compostable kraft bags specifically designed for green waste collection (available at retail stores).



Garbage Collection

FOOD SCRAPS ARE BANNED FROM GARBAGE

BANNED MATERIALS FROM GARBAGE:

- Beverage containers (except paper milk cartons)
- Recyclables accepted in the Recycle BC program; Visit www.recyclebc.ca for a full list
- Corrugated cardboard
- Electronics; personal computers, TVs, printers, small appliances
- Construction/ renovation waste, Gypsum drywall
- Yard, garden and food waste
- Lead-acid car batteries, tires
- Medications/pharmaceuticals
- Newsprint, office paper
- Oil, oil filters & empty containers
- Paints, solvents, flammable liquids, gasoline, pesticides
- Dead animals

Large Items

Single Family residents receiving municipal curbside garbage collection may have four (4) large items such as furniture and appliances picked up by appointment at any time throughout the year.

You can receive multiple reminders via email, phone, Twitter, text message, or embed your reminders in Outlook, Google and iCal calendar. or you can print out a customized PDF calendar.

Garbage limited to TWO 80-litre cans or bags. EVERY OTHER WEEK. Maximum Weight for can or bag: 20kg/44lbs

No "Blue Box" Blue coloured 80-litre cans permitted.



EXTRA GARBAGE STICKERS

Additional cans or bags must have an extra waste sticker attached to them. Stickers may be purchased at Langley City Hall Finance department, Timms Community Centre (20399 Douglas Crescent).

RECYCLING IN THE CITY OF LANGLEY

Recycle BC provides these services to residents. Curbside recycling collection is weekly, on the same day as weekly Green Can and bi-weekly garbage collection. Please check the Curbside Recycling Guide or address search tool for your collection day at <https://recyclebc.ca/langley/>
