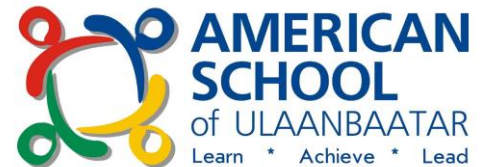

Good Work Habits are critical in high school, in college, for a career, and for the workplace.

Teachers, professors, and employers value:

- ❖ Timeliness: attendance and being on time
- ❖ Diligence: completing assignments and showing good effort
- ❖ Sociability: treating other people — adults, peers, coworkers — with kindness and respect

College Aspiration

*Maintain high expectations by providing adequate supports and building social capital.
Everyone can succeed in college*

What parents can do to support their children:

- ❖ Ensure strict attendance and discipline as a family culture
- ❖ Locate resources for volunteering, shadowing experience to expose students to traditional and nontraditional careers
- ❖ Find and create opportunities
- ❖ Build aspirations to ensure college and career readiness
- ❖ Visit colleges

Academic planning for College and Career Readiness

Students' should plan, prepare and take rigorous academic courses that connect to their college and career aspirations.

Important facts to remember for college readiness:

- ❖ **MAP scores**
- ❖ **PSAT Score**
- ❖ **SAT Score**
- ❖ **Enrollment and Completion of AP courses**

What parents can do to support their children:

- ❖ **Help students to take college/career classes while still in high school (online classes, summer courses...)**
- ❖ **Research college specific acceptance requirements**
- ❖ **Give your child an opportunity to explore their interest**

Enrichment and Extracurricular Engagement

Expose your child to a wide range of extracurricular and enrichment opportunities that build leadership, nurture talents and interests, and increase engagement with the community

Important facts to remember for college readiness:

- ❖ **Participation in enrichment programs (academic support, makerspace, summer programs..)**
- ❖ **Participation in extracurricular programs (sports, MUN, GIN, Debate, NHS, NAHS...)**
- ❖ **Students in Leadership position in enrichment and/or extracurricular programs**

What parents can do to support their children:

- ❖ **Help students to develop portfolios that include their certificates, attendance record, artwork...**
- ❖ **Create and use academic and activity calendar as time management tool for planning and scheduling**
- ❖ **Support, mentor or sponsor enrichment activities**

College and Career Exploration and Selection Processes

Provide early and ongoing exposure to experiences and information necessary to make informed decisions when selecting a college or career

Important facts to remember for college readiness:

- ❖ **Participation in college and career exploration program**
- ❖ **Shadowing, volunteer and internship opportunities**

What parents can do to support their children:

- ❖ **Participate in college and career exploration programs that take place in the city**
- ❖ **Have an open and transparent communication about affordability, expectations and future plans**
- ❖ **Connect your child to mentors and professionals for shadowing experience**

College and Career Assessments

Promote preparation, participation and performance in college and career assessments

Important facts to remember for college readiness:

- ❖ **PSAT**
- ❖ **SAT**
- ❖ **SAT Subject test**
- ❖ **College Comparison Worksheet**
- ❖ **Career Assessment**

What parents can do to support their children:

- ❖ **Be engaged in college search process**
- ❖ **Complete and review college comparison worksheet**

College Affordability Planning

Collect comprehensive information about college costs, options for paying for college, and the financial aid and scholarship processes and eligibility requirements

Important facts to remember for college readiness:

- ❖ **Awareness of financial literacy**
- ❖ **Scholarship Application completion**
- ❖ **CSS Profile**

What parents can do to support their children:

- ❖ **Awareness of financial commitment**
- ❖ **Begin to save**

 - **Institutional Aid**

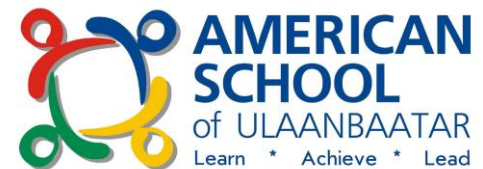
Improve your third and/or fourth language:

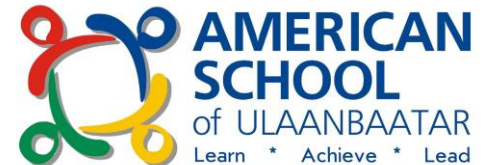

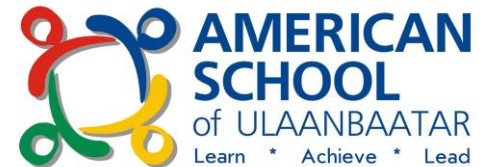
Start a blog:

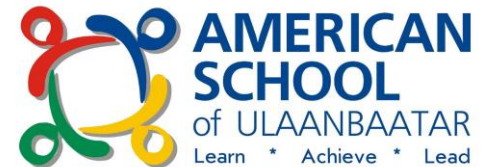
