One thing additionally to look into: Velocity. If you want to hyperlink two servers collectively, you want a proxy. This does simply that and super simple. You probably have any troubles, their discord server is extraordinarily useful.

PaperMC, Purpur, and Tunity also have extraordinarily useful discord servers. top top blog might suggest popping in if in case you have troubles, it's going to save you lots of time.

I like to recommend MSM to your server manager on linux. It's command line based, so if you understand linux, it is great! It manages backups, restarting providers, a number of jars, and more.

Sorry to drag this thread out of the depths, however I would like your thoughts or hyperlink to a "howto for old guys" on getting Fabric to work within MSM. I am operating a couple of servers for a small group of small people, and so they keep harping at me to get a Fabric server up.

Vanilla is simple as pie. Forge took me a pair tries. Each time I hear the phrase "Fabric" I immediately develop a headache.

Edited to say: This is a headless ubuntu construct, because the place I'm going, I often do not have the bandwidth to run a RDP/VNC, so all of my administration is done CLI over SSH.

It relies upon too much on what you plan to do. Should you want a vanilla smp, go Fabric with Lithium. If you want some customization, go together with Purpur (a fork of paper) so you need to use mods.

However paper and Purpur can't run actual mods, can they?

Purpur.

Purpur or Tuinity. I like to recommend purpur, since it is often stable and works nicely. Tuinity would work as effectively, depending on the participant count and lag. I have been operating purpur as my server software program and encountered zero issues with it up to now

If you are going with vanilla smp and never modded smp, then I counsel spigot or the paper spigot fork

Why is this being downvoted? Paper can be wonderful with some optimisation.

Purpur, full cease. Yatopia I've never had points with personally, however from what I've heard with different peoples' experiences, it's totally unstable and is filled with bugs. With Purpur you're getting more or less the identical efficiency without sacrificing much stability.

YatopiaMC is actually dangerous and unstable. Dont use it. It's a random paste and devs dont even know what they're doing + many plugins dont work on YatopiaMC.

If you would like to maintain the vanilla really feel, use Fabric and use these mods.

If you want pure efficiency then use Yatopia which is a fork of many different server software like Paper, Purpur, Tuinity, Airplane, Origami, Akarin, EMC, and mods like Lithium. Also use this guide [\[Information\] Server Optimization | SpigotMC - Excessive Efficiency Minecraft](#).
