- Can demonstrate financial need
- Have the ability to communicate a positive attitude

The application must include the general application information and have the following materials attached:

- 1. An official transcript from your high school guidance department giving evidence of a GPA
- 2. Recommendation from a teacher and, if possible, one other adult who can attest to your character.
- 3. Evidence of acceptance to an institution of higher learning (vocational school or college)

Students must fill out this application form personally. Please be neat, concise and use separate pages only if necessary. All information given will be kept confidential among The Rotary Scholarship Selection Committee.

All applications must be postmarked by Friday, May 3th, 2019. and mailed to the address below .

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
