When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be observed. Read all instructions before using this shaver.

DANGER

To reduce the risk of electric shock:

- 1. Do not reach for an appliance that has fallen into water. Unplug it immediately.
- 2. Do not charge while bathing or in the shower.
- 3. Do not charge this unit near a tub, toilet or sink.

WARNING/IMPORTANT

- 1. Read the instruction manual thoroughly before using the device.
- 2. Use the shaver only for purposes described in this instruction book.
- 3. For the hygienic reason, the shaver should not be shared with others.
- 4. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge.
- 5. Regularly check the foil condition, if signs of damage are visible, do not use.
- 6. Do not use if skin is red, irritated, inflamed, infected or blistered.
- 7. Foils and blades will wear over time and may require replacing.
- 8. This product is for household use only.
- 9. Do not place or store your unit in direct sunlight. Store only in a cool dry place.
- 10. Keep your unit out of reach of children.
- 11. Do not charge the shaver where the temperature is below (32 °F), or higher than (100 °F), or where it will be exposed to direct sunlight or a heat source, or near excessive moisture.
- 12. Use the included charging cord only.
- 13. Dry the shaver completely before charging it.
- 14. Keep the charging cord away from water and handle with dry hands.
- 15. Do not pull, twist, or severely bend the cord.

- 16. Do not wrap the power cord tightly around the appliance.
- 17. Do not take the housing apart.

CHARGING

- 1. Prior to first use, charge for 12 hours.
- 2. Regular Shaving will require 12 hours charging time for 60 minutes of runtime. Usage time may decrease over time.
- 3. Do not overcharge, as this may damage the battery life.
- 4. The shaver will not charge when it is switched on. Be sure to check that the "On/Off switch" is set to "Off" when charging.

SHAVING

HOW TO USE

- Switch on by pushing the on/off switch.
- 2. Hold the shaver at a right angle to your skin.
- 3. Apply gentle pressure as you move the shaver across your face, stretching the skin with your free hand. Move the shaver back and forth to achieve the desired result.
- 4. Applying excessive pressure will not result in a closer shave and may cause irritation or skin damage.
- To use the beard trimmer, slide the trimmer handle up to open the trimmer, place the trimmer at a right angle to your skin and move it down to trim sideburns.

STORAGE

Always store this appliance and adaptor in a moisture-free area.

CLEANING

Press the "Head Removal Catch" to release the "Head Cover". Remove any hair debris after each use using the brush provided.

Rinse the "Head Cover" only under running water and dry thoroughly with a towel.

DO NOT REMOVE THE BATTERY.
