

Proposals — Hilary Term 2017 (Weeks 5, 6, 7 and 8)

Exhibition proposals for Hilary will be accepted up until the **Friday of 3rd week (3rd Feb) at 5pm**. Proposals will be reviewed at this time - it is **not** 1st come 1st served.

You can propose a show lasting from **1 day and up to 1 week**. Both solo shows and group shows will be considered — but note that it is unlikely that a solo show will be accepted for longer than 3 days. If there are 3 or more people involved, and the project is ambitious, a week can be considered. A 'What's On' timetable will then appear in 4th week.

You can also propose a day or so for 'documentation only' which won't appear on the timetable — but these slots will not be given priority — we will fit them in at the end if we can. (Using the space to document work is fine, but if you are going to set up an interesting piece, why not open it in the evening, and have a show anyway?)

Proposals

Proposals need not be long or flowery.

- A **brief description** of how and why you want to use the space is **fine**. Images are a bonus. The description can be vague, and doesn't need to be strictly adhered to when the slot comes.
- A **title** for the show would be especially good to add to the 'What's On', otherwise, your name is also fine. A title can be added later if need be.
- **Specify** the number of days you would like the space for, and the preferred dates. It would be helpful if you were to give a number of options for dates so we can schedule you in when you are free, even better if you are completely flexible, or tell us only dates you can't do. Preferred dates will be kept to as far as possible — but it won't always be. (We may change your date but still offer the space.)
- If you can, try to specify the number of days you will need for the install, as well as the number of days the show will be open for visitors.
- **Opening times** for Private View events etc can be arranged by email/ on social media as usual closer to the time (the 'What's On' will be very basic, and updated as it goes along! It is just to give people an idea) but if you would like to let me know these sometime during 4th week that would be helpful.

Priority will be given to group shows/ collaborations, solo shows by people who haven't exhibited in the the previous term, and solo shows which seem motivated!
