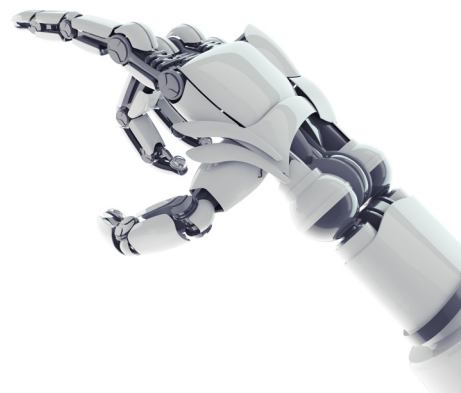

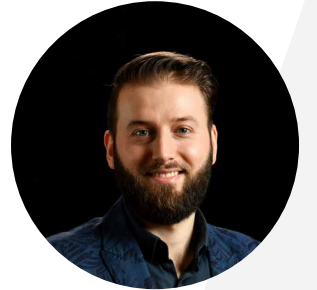

DR. STEFANIE GREEN / This is Assisted Dying

Trained as a family physician, Dr. Stefanie Green spent over 20 years as a leader in maternity and newborn care before changing her focus to become one of Canada’s first practitioners of medical assistance in dying (MAiD). Her pioneering work led her to co-found the Canadian Association of MAiD Assessors and Providers (CAMAP). She is co-lead of the Canadian MAiD Curriculum Project, a multiyear, federally- funded project to develop and help standardize the clinical approach to this care, to educate and train clinicians new to the field, and to enhance the skills of those already involved. Beyond her clinical practice, Dr. Green frequently speaks about assisted dying to a wide range of audiences locally, nationally and internationally, and she has provided expert testimony to subcommittees of both the Canadian House of Commons and the Senate. More recently, Dr. Green is the author of the powerful, internationally- bestselling book, “This is Assisted Dying: A Doctor’s Story of Empowering Patients at the End of Life,” a memoir about her first year providing assisted dying in Canada.

Kal is founder and CEO of a registered charity, KidsPlay Foundation, which provides youth with free high quality educational initiatives, sports programming, and after school mentorship programs. The organization now boasts over 500 volunteers, and approximately 100,000 youth have participated in KidsPlay programs since its inception in 2015. The organization has grown to include chapters located in major cities across Canada, and internationally in Colombia and India.

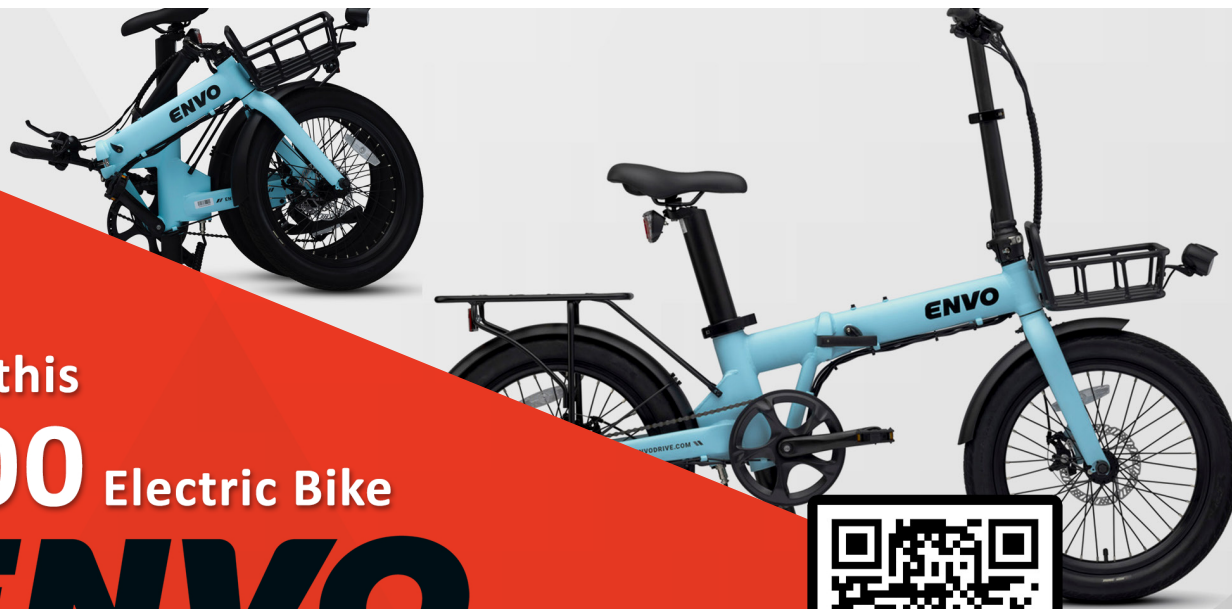

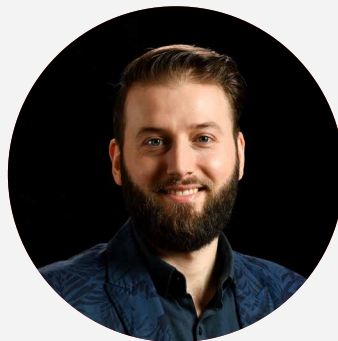
